ORDER

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby ORDERED that defendant U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Motion [45] to Dismiss Plaintiff's FOIA Claims is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART. It is

ORDERED that as to the ACR records search and the search of records at the residence of the vice President, defendant's motion is GRANTED; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that as to the WAVES records search, defendant's motion is DENIED; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff's request for discovery is DENIED; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that defendant U.S. Department of Homeland Security shall immediately process plaintiff Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington's Freedom of Information Act request and produce all responsive records that are not exempt from disclosure within twenty days of this order.
