On June 21, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified Kansans for Huelskamp ("Committee") and Brian A. Weber, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On September 3, 2010, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you, that there is no reason to believe the Committee and Brian A. Weber in his official capacity as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441d(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.


Dear Mr. Ellis:

On September 3, 2010, based upon the information provided in the complaint, and information provided by the respondent, the Commission determined that there was no reason to believe the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Therefore, the Commission decided to close its file in this matter on September 3, 2010.
