Thank you all for your continued professionalism and work ethic. We truly have an incredibly talented team at Interior. Given the proximity to the upcoming election, there have been a couple of questions regarding our communications and social media policy, specifically what is permissible and ethical for distribution. As you know, and Heather and Scott (CC'd) would attest, OCO works very closely with the Departmental Ethics Office, General Law and the rest of the Solicitor's Office on all media engagements, press inquiries, social media posts and other communication tools as appropriate. We do this to ensure our entire Department's operation,

including the Bureau's, is in complete compliance with our statutory obligations. Secretarial and Departmental communications are regularly reviewed by these offices and are <u>always</u> able to be amplified by the bureaus via social media, press releases, etc. when germane to your bureau's operations and functions.

We are all working in service to the American people, as part of President Trump's Administration. In reiterating guidance that the DEO, General Law and our Solicitor's Office have already provided on multiple occasions to the team, it is absolutely permissible to highlight official Presidential actions that impact our Department and the Bureaus. OCO encourages communications that specifically highlight official actions directly taken by President Trump. You all have done a good job of highlighting Executive Orders, enacted legislation, Presidential Memorandums and other such actions in press releases when we act on these directives. This will continue. The same is to be said of our posts on social media, which includes the ability to include President Trump's twitter handle - @realDonaldTrump – in our content. Here is guidance from the DEO that is consistent with the Office of the Special Counsel specific to the use of his official twitter account:

"The President has been using the Twitter handle "@realDonaldTrump" for official purposes since the beginning of his Administration, and the Office of the Special Counsel recognizes that it can be used and retweeted from official government accounts if the content is official, has a nexus to the mission of the agency, and most importantly, does not contain partisan political activity."

With support from the DEO and SOL, when you all use the President's handle, please work with our office to ensure all ethical and legal parameters are considered prior to posting.
