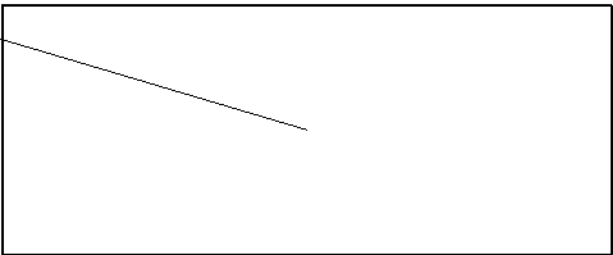
I wanted to catch you up on a few things:

The advocacy for the Community Support program is paying off and clearing the board of Alderman I believe.

Since we spoke, just this morning we had a young women killed and crashed in front of my a member's home who lives across the street from the church. I feel badly seeking help for the neighborhood around the church but crime is up 70% and this neighborhood has got to be secured somehow. I have talked to Judge Edwards and Chief Hayden, but I felt I had to reach out to you. One of our Instructors for our Drum Line Ministry told me the brazenness they witnessed first hand. SUBJECT: Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Request for Temporary Designation of Non-Title 21 Authority Pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 878(a)(5)

PURPOSE: Approval of Temporary Designation of Non-Title 21 Law Enforcement Authority

TIME TABLE: Immediate

SYNOPSIS: The United States Marshal for the District of New Mexico (USMS) is preparing for a planned protest scheduled for 6:00 p.m. MDT on Friday, July 31, 2020, at the United States Courthouse in Albuquerque, New Mexico. In light of recent violent protests at federal properties on the West Coast, the USMS has requested DEA support, in the form of Special Agents, to provide internal security to protect the courthouse from damage. Because the requested support involves enforcing federal criminal laws not related to drugs, DEA requires a grant of additional authority under 21 U.S.C. § 878(a)(5) in order to provide the requested assistance.

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DEA investigative authority, as set forth in 28 C.F.R. § 0.100 and in the Controlled Substances Act, is limited to enforcing federal crimes related to drugs. The protection of the U.S courthouse in

Albuquerque does not fall within the investigative authority granted to DEA. Accordingly, DEA requests authority to perform any and all federal law enforcement duties, including enforcing federal criminal laws not related to drugs, as may become necessary to assist the USMS in protecting this federal property in this specific city this weekend. This authority is requested for Friday, July 31, 2020, through Sunday, August 2, 2020.

AUTHORITY: The Attorney General has the authority to assign non-Title 21 enforcement duties to the DEA under 21 U.S.C. § 878(a)(5), which provides, in pertinent part, that the Attorney General may authorize any officer or employee of the DEA to "perform such other law enforcement duties as the Attorney General may designate." This authority has been delegated to the Deputy Attorney General by 28 CFR § 0.15.

RECOMMENDATION: I hereby certify that this temporary delegation of non-Title 21 law enforcement authority is necessary for the conduct of the activity to which it relates and that the activity is necessary for the public safety and welfare. Therefore, your authorization and approval of the described operation is requested.

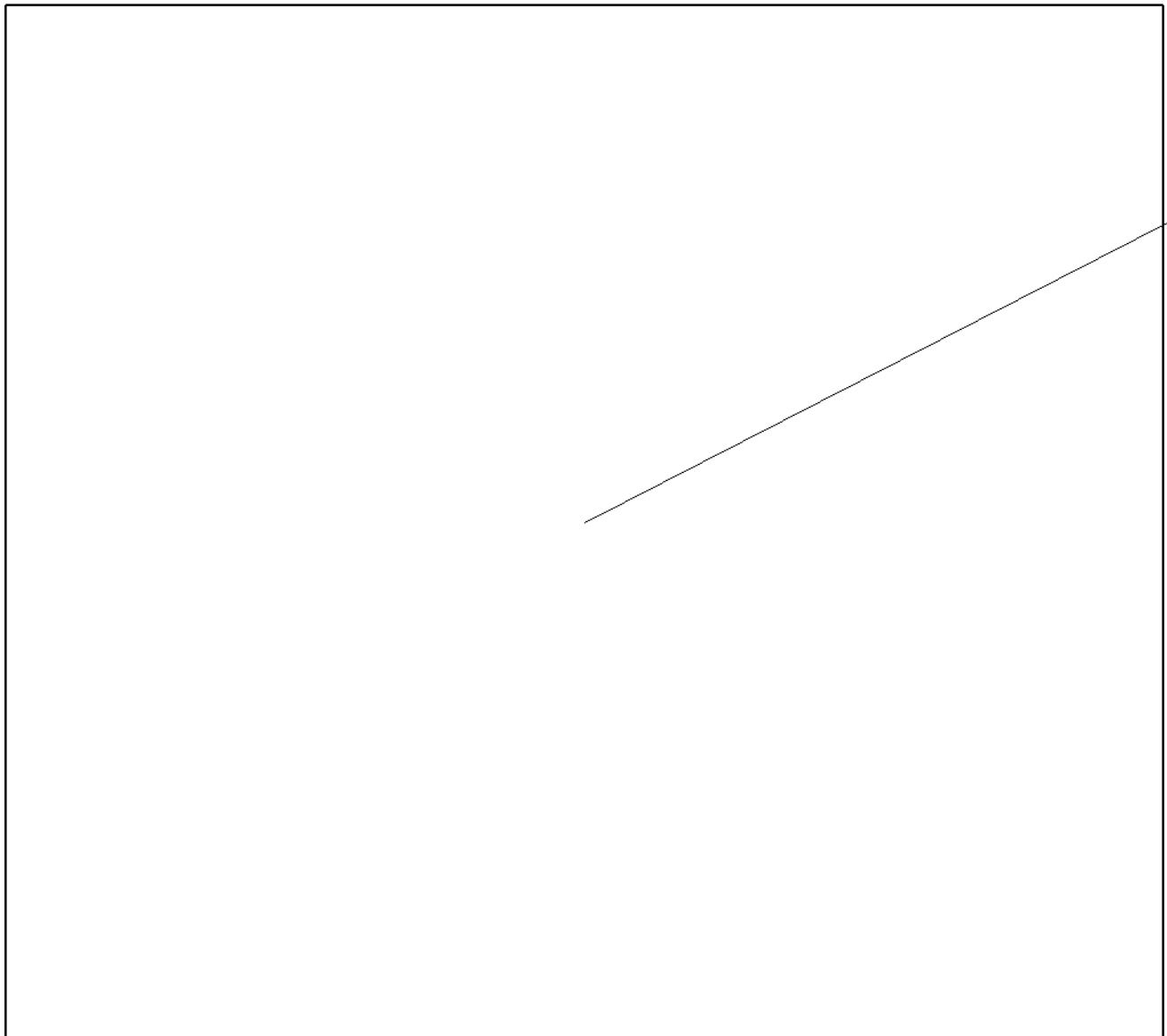

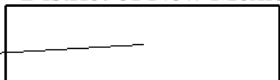
