The Illinois State Police Mobile Field Force team has been activated for civil unrest activity in the Chicagoland area since Saturday, May 30. In this capacity, the ISP deploys MFF personnel to various locations in the greater Chicagoland area. Since this activation, the ISP MFF has been deployed to locations in the City of Chicago and the following suburbs: Oak Forest, Evergreen Park, Cicero, North Riverside, Naperville, and Aurora. Additional activity is planned in the coming days in multiple suburbs and Chicago. Our MFF personnel are deploying as both a reactionary force to active events and staging near protest activity where there is an indication of civil unrest.

Due to the limited resources of the ISP Air Operations wing and only being able to assist the ISP MFF at one event at a time, I am requesting DEA Air Support to assist at various locations in the Chicagoland area when the ISP Air Ops is already deployed and unable to respond.

I am asking for the DEA Air Ops to be available in an on call status to assist our deployments for the next 7 - 10 days.

Your consideration to this request is greatly appreciated.

CIU Social Media reviewed all the events we are tracking for Saturday. There is a massive protest scheduled with almost 10,000 Individuals who have responded to the Facebook event page. The numbers for this event continue to grow and has the potential to be much larger especially being on a Saturday. **** NOTE:** Facebook is very popular with the 28-50 year old range. There will likely be more people from the "younger" generation who do not utilize Facebook and will attend but not respond to this event. We expect the numbers likely be in the 5 to 6 thousand range of who would attend with the potential for 10,000 people to attend. There is a high amount of chatter across ALL major social media platforms.

The numbers from 11AM until now, 1:10PM have increased by 100 more individuals who are going and 100 more interested and is continuing to gain traction on the major Social Media platforms.
