On July 26, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) were conducting mobile surveillance in the area of downtown Portland. At 12:06 agents were notified that there was a drone being operated in the area near Broadway and Main Streets in Portland, OR. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) and SA (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) responded to the area and identified an individual, later identified as (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) holding a control pad, which appeared to have a screen and a joystick. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was wearing black overalls and a red hat with a white logo on the front of it. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) awaited the arrival of a second unit (b)(6); (b)(7)(C). Around 12:15am agents approached (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) and identified themselves. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) asked (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) if he was operating a drone which he stated he was. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) notified him that it was a restricted airspace and he stated that he hadn't known that and would return the drone. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) returned the drone and was asked to provide agents with his identification and he produced his Oregon Driver's License. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was then taken into custody and transported to the Edith Green Wendal Wyatt Federal Building for questioning.

At 12:54am (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) conducted an audio recorded interview of (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) advised (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of his Miranda Rights, which he waived and agreed to answer questions without an attorney present. During the interview he admitted to flying his drone aircraft over the downtown Portland protests on two occasions on the evening of July 25, 2020. He stated that he was taking video to show his family, who live out of the area, that the scope of the protests was not as large as depicted on TV and the Internet. He took video of the protests on

his second flight, however, forgot to record during his first flight. He operated the drone usually at 400 feet and on at least one occasion brought it down to 100 feet. The drone records in 4K, but it does not zoom, and he did not focus in on any police activity or illegal activity by the protesters. His drone is not registered with the FAA, nor does he have a commercial drone license. This was the first night he has attended any of the protests, he was not asked by anyone or directed in anyway by anyone to conduct or record the flight. He is not members of any of the groups associated with the protests but is a member of the VFW and American Legion, as he served in the Air Force. His address [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Present during the interview were FPS Officer [REDACTED] The interview was terminated about 1:22am. Due to a delay in transport agents sat and talked to [REDACTED] and awaited transportation to the US Marshal's. [REDACTED] did not provide any additional relevant information but he did thank agents and indicated that he thought agents were very nice and treated him kind and fairly.

******For full visibility, there have been numerous Law Enforcement officers lasered in the Face and eyes during this past week. FPS is the investigating Agency for all assaults of officers, to include incidents of assaults with lasers to the eyes of officers and investigations are currently ongoing.

0012: Assault on officer using green laser on overwatch position, which caused damage to eye of officer. Teams on the ground are moving subject back into the Hatfield USCH.

*******Multiple law enforcement personnel have been targeted with lasers from the Overwatch position leading to numerous arrests for assaults to federal officers. FPS is the lead investigating Agency for the assaults of officers and investigations are ongoing.

According to FPS this is one of the more action packed nights they've seen of the 54 straight days of protests. Protesters successfully BREACHED Hatfield after prying open the plywood and attempting to enter. Federal Agents deployed CS gas and pepper munitions to prevent people from gaining entry through the point of the building breach.

As tactical units deploy from the building to push back the violent opportunists they were met with resistance resulting in the arrest 5 and individuals. The HSI Duty Agent assisted FPS by taking the bodies of those arrested by the tactical teams and brought inside the courthouse, assisted in searching those arrested and assisted in escorting arrestees to holding cells on the 4th floor of the Hatfield courthouse.

Once the building was secured, HSI Assisted with identifying those arrested by conducting various database queries and further assisted by being a 2nd Agent to interview individuals arrested.


