This is the third response to your client's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).

For this production, DHS reviewed 250 pages. Nineteen (19) pages originated with and have been referred to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) and sixty-three (63) pages have been sent for consultation. Twenty (20) pages are released in full, fifty-eight (61) pages are withheld in part pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(5), (b)(6), and (b)(7)(E), and eleven (11) pages are withheld in full pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(5) and (b)(7)(E). Seventy-six (76) pages were found to be duplicates.
