Following the permitted event at the Ellipse, a large crowd breached police lines at the Capitol to include gaining unauthorized access to the building. US Capitol Police (USCP) made a direct support request to several agencies including the USPP.

MPD declared the activity a riot (per commander assigned to the MPD-JOCC). USCP and MPD both reported empty on less lethal pepper ball at the West Front of the Capitol and were actively being assaulted. Several USCP officers were reported injured. USPP authorized one (1) pepper ball team to support with a Captain and Lieutenant as on scene Unified Command.

USPP had pepper ball and pepper spray engagements with criminal actors actively assaulting officers, destroying property, and crossing a police line.

Major Adamchik deployed to the USCP Headquarters to meet with USCP leadership and remains at that location coordinating with regional agencies.

At this time, one (1) pepper ball team (b) (5), (b) (7)(E)

DSPP beat units have been advised to proactively patrol NPS property. There are no reported issues at NPS properties at the time of this notification. NPS IMT is assisting with logistics and multiple operational periods are being planned by the Special Events Unit.

No reported injuries to USPP personnel. A USPP officer was taken to a hospital (b) (6), (b) (7)(C (unrelated to the incident at the Capitol). Officer is in good condition and communicating with his family.

US Marshal Service SOG was authorized by Acting Chief Smith to assist USPP SWAT and are on station at this time. USMS SOG is the only outside agency working directly under USPP. The NYFO USPP officers are on station and ready for assignment.

At 1800 hours, the chamber of the Lincoln Memorial and the Jefferson Memorial will be closed for precautionary measures. Regular day personnel scheduled to end their tour of duty at 1800 hours are being held until further notice and will remain for response.

USCP continues to develop their operational plan to secure the grounds.

General Overview: Women for America First will conduct a first amendment rally "March for Trump" to demand transparancy and protest election integrity. The rally will feature speakers from Women for America First, Congressional representatives, Roger Stone, Julio Gonzalez, Rudy Guiliani, Diamond and Silk and others. POTUS and family members will be keynote speakers at this event. There is no march associated with this event, although some participants may leave to attend rallies at the United States Capitol to hear the results of Congressional certification of the Electoral College count. This group has significant potential to attract counterprotesters, similar to events in November and December 2020. Multiple acts of violence have occurred in the downtown Washington, DC area during and after similar events hosted by the same organizer.

Access Points: US Secret Service will staff a magnetometer checkpoint at 16th and Constitution Avenue. All event participants will be required to enter at this checkpoint only.

Accounting: All work (regular and overtime) performed in connection with this First Amendment demonstration will be charged to account: PXXUSPPW21A001. 8. Intelligence Report

On 5 January, groups of individuals will begin to arrive in Washington, D.C. in order to participate in planned rallies and demonstrations scheduled for 6 January 2020. These demonstrations will draw groups to the District who hold diametrically opposed social and political views. Within the past 90 days, small sub-groups of the identical organizations attending the 6 January rallies have engaged in violent acts of aggression when these groups are allowed to come into direct contact. While a small rally is planned for the afternoon of 5 January, the main event for this operational period will take place on 6 January at the Ellipse and at the U.S. Capitol. We expect large groups of unorganized individuals will travel between the Ellipse and the U.S. Capitol throughout the day. We expect those lodging in the District on the night of the 6th to return to their hotels, mostly located within the areas of Freedom Plaza and the K Street corridor. The greatest likelihood for violence will occur after sunset when these groups return to their hotels and possibly come into contact with other counter-protest groups.

On 3 January 2021 at approximately 1100 hours, President Trump utilized Twitter to announce he will be attending the permitted event scheduled to take place on the Ellipse on 6 January. As anticipated, this has dramatically increased interest in this event which will draw increased numbers of supporters as well as counterprotestors. A scheduled released by the organizer has POTUS speaking at 1100 hrs. for an undetermined length of time. As long as POTUS has finished speaking, we still expect a large portion of this group to depart the Ellipse at some point and march to the U.S Capitol prior to 1300 hours. (Cont'd next page)

We continue to monitor and investigate social media statements forecasting non-specific acts of violence in the District associated with events schedule for 6 January 2021. While the probability of sporadic violent actions is likely if opposing groups are allowed to come into physical contact with each other, at this time we have no indication of any acts of violence being pre-planned by any specific individual(s) or groups. Several arrests for firearms were made on 5 January 2021 in the downtown area.
