This is the fifth interim response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, originally received by the United States Secret Service (Secret Service) on January 21, 2021, for information pertaining to:

- 1. All records from December 1, 2020 to January 6, 2021 reflecting any plans for demonstrations, gatherings, disruptions, attacks, or riots in Washington, D.C. on January 6, 2021 that were identified by any DHS component—including without limitation the Office of Intelligence & Analysis ("I&A") and the Federal Protective Service ("FPS")—or other agencies through social media monitoring, threat assessments, or other means.
- 2. All records from December 1, 2020 to January 6, 2021 reflecting any tips, complaints, referrals, allegations, or reports submitted to any DHS component—including without limitation I&A and FPS—regarding planned demonstrations, gatherings, disruptions, attacks, or riots in Washington, D.C. on January 6, 2021.
- 3. All records from December 1, 2020 to January 6, 2021 reflecting DHS's communication to other agencies—including without limitation the U.S. Capitol Police, the D.C. Metropolitan Police Department, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the Department of Justice, or the Department of Defense—of the risks or threats posed by planned demonstrations, gatherings, disruptions, attacks, or riots in Washington, D.C. on January 6, 2021.
- 4. All records from December 1, 2020 to January 6, 2021 relating to any DHS component—including without limitation I&A and FPS—providing assistance or support to the U.S. Capitol Police, the D.C. Metropolitan Police Department, or any other agency in connection with the January 6, 2021 congressional session to count electoral votes.

After a detailed review of potentially responsive records, 129 page(s) were released. Exemptions under the FOIA Statute, Title 5 U.S.C. § 552 have been applied where deemed appropriate.

Enclosed are the documents responsive to your request, as well as a document that explains the exemptions in more detail. Withheld information is pursuant to the exemptions marked below.

- 2. <u>Wednesday, January 6, 2021 at 0700 hours</u> for First Amendment demonstrations throughout the District. It will remain activated until all events clear.

If you would like to have a representative for either (or both) of these JOCC activations, please reply directly to me providing the name and contact information for the representative, as well as the hours we should expect the representative to be in the JOCC. I will try my best to ensure that he or she has seating during the event. Please keep in mind that we are extremely limited in spacing due to the current health pandemic and the need to practice social distancing.

Therefore, we are only allowing for one representative from an agency in the JOCC at a time. If



you are no longer the point of contact for your agency, please reply and let me know who the

Health/temperature screenings will be required upon entry into the JOCC. Additionally, face masks are required while inside of MPD facilities. While MPD will have some spare personal protective equipment (PPE) and cleaning materials on site, it is highly recommended that representatives bring their own.

There will not be meals provided during the activation, so please ensure you bring all the personal food and beverage you require for your tour of duty. There are some vending machines in the building as well. Unfortunately, there will be no available refrigerators, so if needed please bring a small cooler if needed. There are some local restaurants that deliver to headquarters as well.

There is wireless connectivity in the JOCC and it is an UNCLASSIFIED/FOUO/LES operating environment, so laptops, cell phones, and agency radios are authorized. If you do not have a laptop with a wireless connection, there are a limited number of DC government computers at some of the work stations that we can facilitate access through. Officers deployed pepper spray after being charged by protestors attempting to enter Black Lives Matter Plaza. Barricades have been brought into the area of Constitution Ave and the Ellipse in preparation for the president's speech.

Thousands of activists gathered at Freedom Plaza, located near Pennsylvania Ave NW and 14th St NW, for a demonstration on Tuesday, January 5. Police have reported that at least two people were arrested during the demonstration; charges for the arrested included possession of firearms and ammunition.

Protest details:

Multiple sources report that protests are planned at several locations in Washington DC today, January 6. The demonstrations have been organized in connection with the congressional vote expected Wednesday to affirm Joe Biden s election victory. Over 340 DC National Guard members have been activated to assist local law enforcement. Good Morning All,

Many of you are probably aware of this by now but there will be another Women For America First (AKA Million MAGA March) First Amendment event to occur in Washington, DC on January 6, 2021. This event was first mentioned by POTUS early Saturday morning when he tweeted about a report concerning election fraud and said that there will be a big protest in D.C. on January 6th and that it "will be wild". Since then, the tweet his gained significant traction and many of the same groups from the November 14th and December 12th events are planning on attending.

Details are still limited at this time but the main organizer is requesting to hold the event at Freedom Plaza, the same location as the previous two events. However, this location has not been approved by NPS at this time. Additionally, the organizer has submitted a parade permit application to MPD from Freedom Plaza to the U.S. Capitol. Expected attendance according to the permit application is the same as before. We are seeing the same upticks in hotel reservations as we did for the previous two events. Some of the counter groups are also aware of this event and have posted messages on social media about countering this event.

The following website provides some information on the event, invited speakers, and hotels with room blocks. The counter groups are already sending out messages to their followers asking them to call the hotels and urge them to cancel reservations so you may start receiving calls from hotels in your AOR regarding harassing phone calls. If this occurs, please let us know.




