STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court’s order dated November 25, 2019, the parties, by and through undersigned counsel, report to the Court as follows.

1. The Complaint in this action under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) was filed on October 18, 2019 against the United States Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”) and the Department of State (“State”). Defendant answered the Complaint on November 25, 2019. Four FOIA requests are at issue in this lawsuit, one to the United States Secret Service (“Secret Service”), a component of DHS, and three to State.

2. The request to the Secret Service, made on August 28, 2019, sought all communications between January 1, 2019 and the present that relate to or support President Trump’s assertion that the Secret Service preferred the Trump National Doral resort as a site for the G-7 summit in 2020. (Compl. ¶ 15) On November 15, 2019, the Secret Service provided a final response to that request, which consisted of the production of one responsive record with
