ORDER

In accordance with the Memorandum Opinion issued on this same day, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment, ECF No. 18, is **GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART**. The motion is **DENIED** as it relates to (1) the individual whose name is withheld from the release of the chain of emails depicted in Exhibit F to the Weeks Declaration, (2) the withholding of former Deputy Secretary Sullivan’s email address domain, and (3) the withholding of Department employee Schachter’s personal email address domain. The motion is **GRANTED** in all other respects. It is further

ORDERED that the Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Partial Summary Judgment, ECF No. 19, is **GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART**. The motion is **GRANTED** as it relates to (1) the individual whose name is withheld from the release of the chain of emails depicted in Exhibit F to the Weeks Declaration, (2) the withholding of former Deputy Secretary Sullivan's email address domain, and (3) the withholding of Department employee Schachter's personal email address domain.
