Dear Laura Iheanachor:

You appealed from the action of U.S. Marshals Service (USMS) on your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for access to records concerning records related to the Rutherford County Juvenile Detention Center in Rutherford County, Tennessee from April 14, 2016, to the date of processing. I note that your appeal concerns the adequacy of USMS's search for responsive records.

After carefully considering your appeal, and as a result of discussions between USMS personnel and this Office, I am remanding your request to USMS for further processing. If USMS locates and determines that additional records are releasable, it will send them to you directly, subject to any applicable fees. You may appeal any future adverse determination made by USMS. If you would like to inquire about the status of this remanded request or to receive an estimated date of completion, please contact USMS directly at (703) 740-3943. Please note that if you are still not satisfied with USMS's search after receiving its response following remand, you may again challenge the adequacy of USMS's search.

If you have any questions regarding the action this Office has taken on your appeal, you may contact this Office's FOIA Public Liaison for your appeal. Specifically, you may speak with the undersigned agency official by calling (202) 514-3642.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your appeal, the FOIA permits you to file a lawsuit in federal district court in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(B).
