Z-holds are currently disfavored especially because ERO's mission is to hold aliens for immigration proceedings and removal.

However, we would like to get back to CRCL regarding this request and if you were amenable to delaying their removal so that CRCL could interview these detainees, please let me know.

### Narrative

Report Title: ERO New Orleans - Spontaneous Use of Force (OC Spray)

The following summary is based on information received from an ERO detention location and on-site ERO and medical staff.

On September 27, 2020, the Adams County Detention Center (ACDC), an Inter-Governmental Service Agreement (IGSA) facility located in Natchez, MS, notified ERO New Orleans of a spontaneous use of force (Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) spray).

ACCC reported that when ACCC staff attempted to escort three ICE detainees, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) all citizens from Cameroon; from the medical department to the Special Housing Unit (SHU). ICE detainees refused to submit to restraints, comply with verbal commands given by ACCC staff and became physically combative with correctional officers, resulting in ADCC staff deploying OC spray.

All detainees subsequently complied with instructions and the use of force was terminated. ACCC staff-initiated decontamination procedures and medical evaluations of all detainees exposed directly and indirectly to the OC spray. No injuries were noted in the medical evaluations. It was later determined that the ICE detainees thought they were being removed from the United States and do not want to go home to their native country of Cameroon.
