Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington (“CREW”) makes this request for records pursuant to the Missouri Sunshine Law, Chapter 610 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri.

First, CREW requests copies of any communications, dated January 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023, pertaining to or mentioning (1) the Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) or (2) David Becker, former board member of ERIC, between the Office of the Secretary of State and any of the following individuals:

- Jeff Elrod, Alabama Director of Elections;
- Frank LaRose, Ohio Secretary of State;
- Amanda (Mandi) Grandjean, Ohio Director of Elections and Deputy Assistant Secretary of State; or
- Thomas Fitton, President of Judicial Watch.

Second, CREW requests copies of any communications, dated (1) September 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021 and (2) January 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023 pertaining to or mentioning (1) the Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) or (2) David Becker, former board member of ERIC, between Secretary of State John (Jay) Ashcroft, and any of the following individuals:

- Chrissy Peters, Missouri Senior Director of Elections; or
- Shane Hamlin, Executive Director, ERIC.

Please search for responsive records regardless of format, medium, or physical characteristics. We seek records of any kind, including paper records, electronic records, audiotapes, videotapes, photographs, data, and graphical material. Our request includes without limitation all correspondence, letters, emails, text messages, facsimiles, telephone messages, voice mail messages, and transcripts, notes, or minutes of any meetings, telephone conversations, or discussions. Our request also includes any attachments to emails and other records, as well as emails to which the subjects of this request were cc'ed or bcc'ed.

If it is your position that any portion of the requested records is exempt from disclosure, you are required to state the basis of the exemption you contend is applicable. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.024.2 (2004). CREW further requests that you state in writing and with particularity the reasons for any conclusion that a record is exempt or confidential. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.024.2 (2004). If some portions of the requested records are properly exempt from disclosure, you are required to redact those portions and produce the remainder of the requested records. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.024.1 (2004).

CREW agrees to pay up to \$100 for copies of the requested records. If copying fees are expected to exceed this amount, please contact me.


If you believe this request is ambiguous or overly broad such that the requested information cannot be reasonably identified, please inform me so that the request can be revised or negotiated in accordance with how records are maintained and accessed in the ordinary course of the office's duties. If it is necessary to file an action to enforce the Missouri Sunshine Law, the court may award reasonable costs of enforcement, including attorneys' fees. Mo. Rev. Stat. § 610.027.3 (2004).
