Goals and benefits

- Build evidence to support program and policy decisions moving forward from Phase 1
- Build evidence that is comparable across components, so that components can learn from one another's experiences

Types of questions an evaluation can answer

- How can the program be optimized for efficiency and effectiveness?
(sooner – *formative evaluation*)
- How effective is the program in achieving its intended outcomes?
(later – *outcome evaluation*)



Ingredients for a successful evaluation

- Measurable outcomes
- Metrics that are already captured in data or could be captured through new data collection
- *Bonus:* Feasibility of implementing different versions in different units



Questions for follow-up meetings

- What are the hard choices going into your BWC policy?
- Is there potential to test by implementing different versions in different units?
- What data will be collected?
- What additional data could be collected to yield measurable outcomes?

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
