Defendant and Intervenor Donald J. Trump (“President Trump”), submits the following supplemental authorities:

1. *Opinion and Order, Robert Davis v. Jocelyn Benson et al.*, State of Michigan Court of Claims, Case No. 23-000128-MB, November 14, 2023 (holding that Michigan law does not provide a clear legal duty to the Secretary of State regarding placing President Trump on the primary ballot such that such action would be ministerial and that, to the extent that Michigan law prohibits the Secretary of State from removing President Trump from a presidential primary or general election ballot on the ground that he cannot serve under Section 3 of the Fourteenth Amendment, that law is not unconstitutional);

2. *Opinion and Order, Robert LaBrant et al. v. Jocelyn Benson*, State of Michigan Court of Claims, Case No. 23-000137-MZ, November 14, 2023 (holding that whether President Trump is barred from serving as President of the United States pursuant to Section 3 of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment is not ripe until President Trump becomes the president-elect and also that this question is a non-justiciable political issue); and,

3. *Opinion and Order, Donald J. Trump v. Jocelyn Benson*, State of Michigan Court of Claims, Case No. 23-000151-MZ, November 14, 2023 (holding that whether President Trump is barred from serving as President of the United States pursuant to Section 3 of the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment is not ripe until President Trump becomes the president-elect and also that this question is a non-justiciable political issue).
