## RE: Freedom of Information Act Request: NGC21-710; 21-cv-01106

Dear Laura Iheanachor and Nikhel Sus:

This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), dated August 16, 2021, which was received in our office on the same day via *FOIAonline*. We assigned your request internal tracking number NGC21-710 in addition to *FOIAonline* tracking number NARA-NGC-2021-001268. In your initial request you sought the following:

Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington ("CREW") makes this request for records pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 U.S.C. § 552, and the National Archives and Records Administration ("NARA") regulations. Specifically, CREW requests the following:
