The following are local and national intel updates since the last report.

INTEL UPDATES

Baltimore City

- 1500: Large protest with crowd estimates of 8,000-10,000. All peaceful at this time
- 1700: Crowd has thinned out to about 200 at city hall. Group is peaceful, no incidents to report

DC

- MPD reporting approximately 2000-3000 demonstrators at Lincoln memorial and approximately 4000 demonstrators at Lafayette Park. All peaceful at this time.

Ocean City

- Main event concluded without incident at approx. 2:10 pm

Anne Arundel County

- (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) AACO Intel @ 1304: We have about 50 counter-protesters near Tick Neck Park with several signs to include "Fuck Your Feelings."
- (b)(6), (b)(7)(C) MCAC @ 1307: AACO PD reports 50 people opposed to "possible BLM rioting" are in entrance of Tick Neck Park. No BLM demonstrators are there yet.

- Tick Neck Park Protest in Pasadena has concluded without incident. Total estimate 1000 people

MCAC

- Group targeting Vince's Crab House in Middle River due to racially insensitive posts from owner. BaCoPD aware. Vines has locations in Baltimore and Harford County.
 - Vince's Crab House 610 Compass Road had 200 protestors due to bias comment on facebook by owner. Crowd is beginning to thin out. Two other county locations have 6 total protestors. No issues reported.

- Harford County has protestors forming at Vines Crab House, 2108 Fallston Road. We have adjusted manpower and have a command post and primary staging set up at the Chenoweth Center 1707 Fallston Road. So far we sent one MFF team, a less lethal team, prisoner wagon, and an arrest team. About 50-75 people at Vines Seafood at this time, crowd dwindling.

Good Morning,

I'm being advised the first protest for this morning appears to be canceled, however the one this evening is getting some attention. I've been advised that if you choose to respond to the area and stand alongside PD, you should report to CRCC – This is not the CP and do not ask for the CP location over the radio, this information is not being released for OPSEC reasons. If they need bodies at other locations such as federal courthouse, old courthouse, jail help, help out there. There are several good targets for protester in a two or three block radius.

If you choose to respond- you should be prepared; water, vests, helmet, eye pro, baton, flashlight – some type of face covering. I wouldn't suggest bringing a rifle, but do what you are comfortable with. Do not show up late to the party – other federal agencies showed up late during the last protest and it was noticed. If you have PPE for gas bring it, we were downwind, but luckily nothing was used. We always ask PD to assist us, this is our chance to assist them. Stay safe and remember what you are trained to do and haven't been trained to do. If you haven't been trained/equipped to be a law enforcement officer then you should not respond – stay home and do not be a liability. If you are trained to be a law enforcement officer then you should at least be ready to respond.

Listen to (b)(7)(E) and Central Channels (unsecured) – pay attention to the safe route, if you do not hear it before you arrive then ask (b)(7)(E) don't call your go-to officers, they may be a little busy. I imagine the safe route to CRCC (b)(7)(E)
(b)(7)(E)

Keep in mind, you are not trained/equipped for mobile field force so try not to insert yourself into riot control team (they will be the ones wearing riot gear) you wouldn't stack up with SWAT...

Find work, get some experience, and help, be there for the right reason. Most of the protestors were 'friendly' at PD HQ where we were during the last protest, thanking PD for their service. So keep in mind that not everyone will be hostile, and this isn't Dallas, Minneapolis, or NYC.

Good Morning,

I'm being advised the first protest for this morning appears to be canceled, however the one this evening is getting some attention. I've been advised that if you choose to respond to the area and stand alongside PD, you should report to CRCC – This is not the CP and do not ask for the CP location over the radio, this information is not being released for OPSEC reasons. If they need bodies at other locations such as federal courthouse, old courthouse, jail help, help out there. There are several good targets for protester in a two or three block radius.

If you choose to respond- you should be prepared; water, vests, helmet, eye pro, baton, flashlight – some type of face covering. I wouldn't suggest bringing a rifle, but do what you are comfortable with. Do not show up late to the party – other federal agencies showed up late during the last protest and it was noticed. If you have PPE for gas bring it, we were downwind, but luckily nothing was used. We always ask PD to assist us, this is our chance to assist them. Stay safe and remember what you are trained to do and haven't been trained to do. If you haven't been trained/equipped to be a law enforcement officer then you should not respond – stay home and do not be a liability. If you are trained to be a law enforcement officer then you should at least be ready to respond.

Listen to (b)(7)(E) and Central Channels (unsecured) – pay attention to the safe route, if you do not hear it before you arrive then ask (b)(7)(E) don't call your go-to officers, they may be a little busy. I imagine the safe route to CRCC (b)(7)(E)

Keep in mind, you are not trained/equipped for mobile field force so try not to insert yourself into riot control team (they will be the ones wearing riot gear) you wouldn't stack up with SWAT...

Find work, get some experience, and help, be there for the right reason. Most of the protestors were 'friendly' at PD HQ where we were during the last protest, thanking PD for their service. So keep in mind that not everyone will be hostile, and this isn't Dallas, Minneapolis, or NYC.
