Good afternoon! Here are the alleged incident of contempt. HQ needs to know if any of these instances could have involved HSI personnel. I am available to discuss.

Instances of alleged contempt.

- a. July 23 at 1 am – a report named (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was by the courthouse. He was trying to take a photograph and a federal agent directly shot him. There were no other protestors around.
- b. July 24 around 11:50 pm – a legal observer wearing a green hat named (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) was shot in the chest from four feet away by a federal agent. She was around the intersection of SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. and SW Salmon.
- c. July 23/July 24 @ approximately 12:45 am – a couple of legal observers on SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave were facing the courthouse. One was an ACLU observer wearing a blue vest named (b)(6); (b)(7)(C). She was shot in the head with a paint bullet. Another observer, Rochelle Collins, was shot in the neck with a paint bullet. They were about 6-10 feet from the protestors, near members of the press.
- d. July 25 @ 11:30 pm – legal observer (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) and another legal observer, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) were with a number of other legal observers from NLG. They were on SW Salmon a few feet from SW 3<sup>rd</sup> at a fence. A federal officer sprayed all of them with mace. Plaintiffs' counsel claims they were not trying to knock over the fence.
- e. July 24 @ 1:30 am – a number of federal agents left the courthouse walking up SW Main. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) a member of the press, was walking across SW Main filming agents. She was shot in the hand. Approximately 10 minutes later, she was walking down SW Salmon, and officers ordered her to clear out. She was with a group of reporters. This would have been at approximately 1:40 am.
- f. July 24 @ 4:00 am – a line of federal agents were crossing the intersection in front of the courthouse. Protestors had largely cleared out, but there were journalists around. One of those journalists was (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) who was wearing a journalist vest. One of the remaining protestors approached the federal official holding flowers. That protestor was arrested (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) tried to take pictures of the arrest. Meanwhile, a federal official from within the courthouse targeted Mr.

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) with his laser tracker, and ultimately shot him at or around the time tear gas was released.

g. July 25 – federal agents launched tear gas into a group of press that included Mr. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) Plaintiffs' counsel offered to send video footage of the incident.

As I previously stated, HSI Portland has been providing support to FPS in an At-Hoc manner, mainly assisting FPS agents with a variety of investigative support functions (database queries), assisting interviews (as a 2<sup>nd</sup> to FPS) and by providing plain clothes surveillance when it was deemed safe to do so. On July 20, 2020, as a response to the ongoing civil unrest, the Deputy Criminal Chief for the District of Oregon requested the presence of the following agencies in an attempt to draft an investigative plan moving forward related to the ongoing civil unrest in Portland. Present for the meeting was the Criminal Chief for the USAO, the Deputy Chief and representatives from the US Marshals Service, IRS, HSI, FPS and BORTAC.

Background – Currently the US Attorney’s office has (b)(7)(A) federal defendants facing a variety of charges related to criminal activity tied to the civil unrest. Of the (b)(7)(A) 1 is facing Arson charges, 1 Felony Assault and (b)(7)(A) are related to laser strikes to officers face/eyes. Many of those arrested appear to be from other states, California, Arizona, New York and Texas to name a few. Seized along with the arrests was pocket trash, personal use narcotics and in some cases mobile devices. It is the opinion by many of the intel and tactical components present in Portland assisting with this operation, that the group of violent opportunists (VOs) are highly organized and as such may be part of a larger criminal conspiracy. Additionally, the VOs have ratcheted up their tactics against the federal law enforcement present by increasing their online threats/doxing of Law Enforcement, use of Drones to record law enforcement tactics, use of radio jamming devices to render law enforcement radios ineffective, use of wrist rockets to shoot ball bearings at tactical units and the use of crude incendiary devices to injure law enforcement or damage federal property.

**HSI Portland will continue to provide (b)(7)(E) Agents and (b)(7)(E) Analyst to support the FPS mission daily from 1800 – 2400 (or until FPS sends the shift home) through June 7. HSI Portland will extend its support past June 7 if FPS deems the continued support necessary.**

**Overview:** DHS law enforcement personnel were forced to engage demonstrators with tear gas and smoke in Portland, OR.

**Report:** At 0716 EDT (0416 PDT) FPS reported protestors were blocking the entrance to the Edith Green Federal Building; Border Patrol personnel who were on foot could not enter the building. ICE ERO personnel responded to assist and were met with resistance. Protestors threw canned food and other hard objects at Border Patrol personnel and refused to comply with orders. Border Patrol personnel deployed tear gas and smoke into the area and pushed the protestors to the nearby Mark O. Hatfield Federal Courthouse. FPS personnel deployed outside, in front of the Courthouse, secured the front entrance

and Border Patrol personnel were able to safely enter the building. All federal personnel are secure inside the building.
