On consideration of plaintiff Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington's (CREW) motion for a preliminary injunction and partial summary judgment, the opposition thereto, reply memorandum, and the full record in this case, it is hereby

ORDERED that CREW's motion is **GRANTED**.

And it is further **DECLARED** that Defendants' removal of the Public Apportionments

Database and public access to apportionment information violates the Consolidated

Appropriations Act, 2023 (2023 Act) and the Paperwork Reduction Act; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants shall restore the Public Apportionments Database and make publicly available the apportionment information required to be disclosed by the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (2022 Act) and the 2023 Act; and it is further

ORDERED that Defendants are **ENJOINED** from removing the Public Apportionments

Database and the apportionment information required to be disclosed by the 2022 Act and 2023

Act from a publicly accessible website without statutory authorization.
