

(U/<del>FOUO)</del> On 3 July, Portland, Oregon police declared a riot in the vicinity of the U.S. Federal Courthouse due to violent criminal activity. According to Portland Police and Federal Protective Service (FPS), protesters began throwing fireworks, sling-shooting rocks at FPS officers, and starting fires. United States Marshals (USMS) extinguished a fire that was started after protesters threw incendiary devices (NFI) at the building. Subjects broke the glass doors of the Courthouse and attempted a breach of the building but were stopped by USMS and FPS. USMS arrested two individuals; one who attempted to breach the courthouse and another individual who had firework smake bombs. One subject was released without being charged.



- (U/\(\textit{FOUO}\)\) On 30 June in Fargo, North Dakota, an unknown subject left what appeared to be a pipe bomb at the door of a business located across the street from the Federal Building United States Post Office \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ The device appeared to be a pipe bomb with wires, a circuit board and what appeared to be a clock. The police cordoned off the area and local bomb squad confirmed the device was a hoax. The investigation is ongoing.
- \* (U/<del>/LES)</del> Since 25 May, 31 of 56 (55%), field offices reported 64 incidents of damage to federal property or landmarks, including damage to eight FBI facilities. The bar chart below depicts updated instances of damage to federal property reported between 0600 25 May and 1000 3 July.



(U/7.ES) On 3 July, Aurora Police Department in Colorado is expected to release results of an
internal investigation that may result in discipline to three Aurora Police officers photographed while
reenacting the August 2019 death of Elijah McClain who died of cardiac arrest during an arrest. The
release of the investigative results and the photos taken by the officers may be a flash point for
violence associated with planned demonstrations and protests in Aurora this weekend.

#### (U) Scheduled Protests

(U/<del>FOUO)</del> Criminal actors may exploit lawful protests over the next 24-72 hours to perpetuate acts of violence. From 30 June to 3 July, 12 field offices reported scheduled lawful protests in their AOR (BF, DN, 3N, ME, NK, NY, OC, PD, RH, SE, SU, and WF):

- (U/7LES) There are numerous planned lawful demonstrations for 3 and 4 July at or in the vicinity of
  federal properties and monuments in Washington, D.C. which could impact the level of
  violent/criminal activity over the next 72 hours. According to law enforcement partners in the
  Washington, D.C. area, some planned protests are anticipated to draw large crowds in proximity to
  national monuments.
- (U) As of 2 July 2020, Brandon, Mississippi Police Department informed federal authorities of a unity rally/protests in support of removing Confederate monuments on 3 July near the Brandon courthouse.



(U/<del>FOUO)</del> There is a planned protest gathering at Iowa State Capitol Building in Des Moines, Iowa, on 4 July from 1300-1500 (local time). The gathering could be exacerbated by an incident that took place on 1 July, in which a planned peaceful protest resulted in 17 arrests due to alleged damage to police vehicles and conduct toward law enforcement officers. The federal Iowa Central District

courthouse is located approximately 0.6 miles away. Coordination with local law enforcement is ongoing.

(U) Positive Mitigation Factors/trends - appearing to have a positive impact on tamping down the violence in an AOR including local curfews, National Guard presence, and enhanced police presence.
