Charges include assaults on law enforcement officers, destruction of federal property, and disorderly conduct

PORTLAND, Ore.—U.S. Attorney Billy J. Williams announced today that seven people have been arrested and face federal charges for their roles in weekend riots at the Mark O. Hatfield U.S. Courthouse in Portland.

According to court documents, since May 26, 2020, protests in downtown Portland have regularly been followed by nightly criminal activity including assaults on law enforcement officers, destruction of property, looting, arson, and vandalism.

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Portland, is charged with disorderly conduct, creating a hazard on federal property, and failing to obey a lawful order (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Oceanside, California, is charged with destruction of federal property; and (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Beaverton, Oregon; (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Seattle, Washington; (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Portland; (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Portland; and (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) of Eugene, Oregon, are charged with assaulting federal officers.

The Hatfield Federal Courthouse has been a repeated target of vandalism, sustaining extensive damage. U.S. Marshals Service deputies and officers from the Federal Protective Service, Homeland Security Investigations, and U.S. Customs and Border Protection working to protect the courthouse have been subjected to threats; aerial fireworks including mortars; high intensity lasers targeting officers' eyes; thrown rocks, bottles, and balloons filled with paint from demonstrators while performing their duties.

On July 2-3, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) is accused of using his body to push on and hold a glass door at the Hatfield Courthouse closed, preventing officers from exiting the building and causing the door to shatter. With the door broken, a mortar firework entered the courthouse, detonating near the officers. The officers used shields and their bodies to block the open doorway for approximately six hours until demonstrators dispersed.

On July 4, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) is accused of willfully destroying a closed-circuit video camera mounted on the exterior of the Hatfield Courthouse.

On July 5, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) is accused of assaulting a federal officer with a shield while the officer was attempting to arrest another protestor.

On July 5-6, 2020, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) are accused of assaulting federal officers with high intensity lasers. At the time of his arrest, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) also possessed a sheathed machete.

All seven defendants made their first appearances in federal court on July 6, 2020 and were released pending trial.

A criminal complaint is only an accusation of a crime, and a defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.

These cases are being investigated jointly by the U.S. Marshals Service; FBI; U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives; Federal Protective Service; U.S. Customs and Border Protection; and Homeland Security Investigations.

No, we have not corroborated any information on active protests/riots targeting the ICE facility in Portland. As you said (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) we have been assisting FPS with (b)(7)(E) and (b)(7)(E) nightly since May 30 from 6PM to 12AM or later. ERO has been providing (b)(7)(E) nightly as well. FPS has not made any additional requests for HSI assistance here locally and has advised that our current level of support is sufficient.

The below could also be a result of FPS's most recent request to Border Patrol for additional bodies to help secure additional NON-ICE facilities within the Portland area. On a conference call yesterday, BP noted all the less than lethal munition systems they had available which FPS was very interested in. Below is the excerpt from an earlier FPS email message to BP that I was cc'ed on:

"Also, the US Attorney District of Oregon just met with Portland Police. For the last few days there has been a barrier system of bollards and fence surrounding the downtown core including the Hatfield USCH and Edith Green Wendell Wyatt Building. The City of Portland is taking that down ASAP as they are experiencing crowd sizes too big to secure a barrier system that large. They expressed that violence against LE is increasing in Portland. BLUF is they are telling us they don't think they'll be able to protect federal facilities.

In talking with the US Attorney and Marshal in Spokane they indicated that things are fairly stable there. Chief (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) could Spokane Sector USBP support the facilities in Portland? If so, how soon?

Subject: Activity Summary 07/01/20

20:38 – Protesters place barricades on the Southside of 3rd and Main. Approximately 30 vehicles drove past Hatfield and JC honking horns.

20:55 – Protesters have blocked 3rd Ave between Main and Madison

21:05 – Approximately 50 protesters are on 3rd between Main and Madison

21:10 – A fire has been set at the Elk statue on Main

21:41 – Protesters are tagging the plywood at Hatfield

21:50 – Approximately 150 protesters outside JC and Hatfield

22:48 – Approximately 200 protesters around the Elk statue and in the parks. Multiple protesters tagging Hatfield

23:00 – protesters setting off fireworks, barricading Westside of 3rd and Main intersection

23:10 – Protesters begin moving plywood covering the GSA windows. Protesters are burning the plywood at the Elk statue and using it to fortify their barrier

23:23 - Protesters have now begun moving plywood along the front of Hatfield. I called FPS to respond to remove the protesters from federal property

Was in communication with PPB. They do not

have the resources to assist in dispersing the crowd (approximately 300) due to lack of personnel on shift.

00:05 – additional FPS units arrive (b)(7)(E). Protesters return to Hatfield to remove additional plywood. Protesters also begin throwing objects at the front windows (large pieces of plywood and large metal pipe). FPS deploys out of the front of Hatfield and pushes protesters back to the park.

01:00 – protesters are gathered on Main between 3rd and 4th Ave. Protesters are heard telling the crowd to leave Hatfield alone, that their issue is with PPB and not with the “Feds”, crowd had a little internal argument over the subject but decided it was best to leave Hatfield alone.

01:30 – Protesters are shooting roman candles at the JC and occasionally near Hatfield. Mortars are thrown at the front of the JC.

01:43 – a Few protesters are tagging the outside of Hatfield, a straggler will occasionally come up to the exposed windows to look at the graffiti or take pictures.

02:30 – Approximately 50 protesters remain. The group is thinning rapidly

03:00 – Approximately 20 protesters remain near the Elk statue. PPB called out a possible altercation amongst the group. Protesters are dispersing on their own west and north.

03:43 – Approximately 5-8 protesters milling about the park (could be homeless). Work crew has arrived to remove the barricade on 3rd and Main.

04:00 – All is quiet, plywood and steel pipe were retrieved and brought into the lobby.

20:55 – Protesters have blocked 3rd Ave between Main and Madison

21:05 – Approximately 50 protesters are on 3rd between Main and Madison

21:10 – A fire has been set at the Elk statue on Main

21:41 – Protesters are tagging the plywood at Hatfield

21:50 – Approximately 150 protesters outside JC and Hatfield

22:48 – Approximately 200 protesters around the Elk statue and in the parks. Multiple protesters tagging Hatfield

23:00 – protesters setting off fireworks, barricading Westside of 3rd and Main intersection

23:10 – Protesters begin moving plywood covering the GSA windows. Protesters are burning the plywood at the Elk statue and using it to fortify their barrier

23:23 - Protesters have now begun moving plywood along the front of Hatfield. I called FPS to respond to remove the protesters from federal property

FPS and USMS personnel are taking bottles, paint balls, and fireworks (mortars, smoke bombs, and a possible M80). FPS is able to push protesters back from Hatfield and falls back inside. Was in

communication with PPB. They do not have the resources to assist in dispersing the crowd (approximately 300) due to lack of personnel on shift.

00:05 – additional FPS units arrive (b)(7)(E) Protesters return to Hatfield to remove additional plywood. Protesters also begin throwing objects at the front windows (large pieces of plywood and large metal pipe). FPS deploys out of the front of Hatfield and pushes protesters back to the park.

01:43 – a Few protesters are tagging the outside of Hatfield, a straggler will occasionally come up to the exposed windows to look at the graffiti or take pictures.

02:30 – Approximately 50 protesters remain. The group is thinning rapidly

03:00 – Approximately 20 protesters remain near the Elk statue. PPB called out a possible altercation amongst the group. Protesters are dispersing on their own west and north.

03:43 – Approximately 5-8 protesters milling about the park (could be homeless). Work crew has arrived to remove the barricade on 3rd and Main.

04:00 – All is quiet, plywood and steel pipe were retrieved and brought into the lobby.

After taking a look at the tip/lead and site, I spoke to the DC analyst POC and she concurs that the site does not appear to be of further investigative interest as its purpose is to aggregate news based twitter posts and geolocates them to an area based on the post. The site is basically automated, and it doesn't seem to take user submitted posts via a hashtag or other means. Rather it uses its own algorithm to find posts.

However it may be a helpful tool for analysts to use for other purposes, for that very reason.
