11.0. ACCESS TO BODY-WORN CAMERA RECORDINGS

Subject to the restrictions in this interim policy, DEA personnel may access and view DEA BWC recordings only for official DEA business, including assisting in accurate report writing and preparing for testimony. **NOTE:** The purpose of using BWC recordings in preparing DEA-6 forms and preparing for testimony is to maximize the accuracy of the report or testimony—not to replace independent recollection and perception of an event.

Those are the sum of what USMS feels would be good additions and the modified language in the attached is our suggested language.

Additionally, as we all are getting training underway (or completed), USMS begins training in our locations Monday.

We will not authorize the actual active use of the BWC until we do have a policy document returned to ensure we can properly advise the field of all the conditions under which they will be using BWC and that the agency will be implementing regarding every facet, including public release. (This is FYSA to manage expectations of this group. If interim policy is returned as final for Phase 1, we'll activate the day after training concludes in each location for a rolling start across the USMS for the rest of this month.)

Here are the USMS Locations (All-please return yours with dates if you would so we're all aware of the scope of our Phase 1 as DOJ partners):

District of New Hampshire-training 9/13 and 9/14 (all USMS personnel)

District of Minnesota-training 9/16 and 17 (all USMS Personnel)

Western Texas- El Paso-training 9/20 and 21; San Antonio-training 9/23 and 24 (all USMS personnel assigned to those 2 locations in W/TX)
Northern District of Georgia and SE Regional Fugitive Task Force (Atlanta office)-training 9/28 and 29 (all USMS personnel in N/GA and all SERFTF Atlanta personnel)

We will have approximately 175 BWC in use across those 5 areas by 9/30 (dependent on the final interim policy being returned). If anyone is interested in having a monthly teleconference to discuss Phase 1 and/or any issues where we might have co-located personnel wearing BWC, please advise and we'll be happy to host that virtually or in person if anyone wants to finally meet face to face at any time.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- Phase One of USMS usage of BWCs: anticipated to start the week of September 13th (on or about 09/15)
- Phase One Locales:
 - o Southeast Regional Fugitive Task Force (SERFTF) – Georgia
 - o District of New Hampshire (D/NH) - Concord
 - o Western District of Texas (W/TX) – El Paso, San Antonio
 - o Minnesota (D/MN) - Minneapolis
- USMS procured Axon BWCs and Axon docking stations for Deputy United States Marshals (DUSMs) wearing BWCs. USMS is utilizing the Axon Video Retention Solution that was procured during TFO BWC pilot program.
- Agency currently setting up and staffing a new Body Worn Camera Program Office (BWCPO).
- Agency also has a BWC Group within the FOIA Unit, Office of the General Counsel.
 - Responsible for responding to requests for BWC footage from state/federal prosecutors, defense attorneys, civil litigants, law enforcement agencies, and members of the public.



USMS and USAO Interaction

- When will you need USMS BWC footage?
 - As per policy, BWCs will initially be utilized during the execution of arrest and search warrants.
 - USMS has a fugitive apprehension mission; typically, the Agency is not involved with substantive case development or investigation (with few subject matter exceptions).
 - May need footage in connection with felon in possession cases.
 - If so: the DUSM recommending pursuing the felon in possession charge will ensure BWC evidence is sent directly to you, along with any other relevant evidence. The DUSM will coordinate the release of evidence (whether BWC footage or reports) with appropriate OGC personnel.
 - Civil Division: may need BWC footage in connection with reviewing *Touhy* requests.



USMS AND USAO INTERACTION CONT

- How do I get USMS BWC Footage?
 - BWC footage is just another type of evidence. You can request BWC footage the same way you request USMS investigatory reports – make the request to the USMS Office of the General Counsel (OGC).
 - Make the request directly to General Counsel Lisa Dickinson – (b)(6)/(b)(7)(C) - per USMS. The request will then be assigned to an OGC attorney who will work with the BWC Group to provide you with the footage.
 - Provide a name and FID with your request. Additionally, provide the name of the case agent.
 - The BWC Group will make sure you are provided with a redacted and unredacted version of the BWC footage.
 - NOTE: you will be sent the footage via email with a link to Axon – you MUST click on the link and download the footage. The link will expire TWO WEEKS after it is sent to you. Once downloaded, the footage is yours.



RETENTION SPECIFICS

(b)(7)(E) - per USMS

- USMS will retain all footage for a 180-day period, in accordance with the DOJ Policy on transitory records.
 - See: DOJ Order 0801.04 [Electronic Mail and Electronic Messaging Records Retention](#)
- If there exists an operational need to keep the footage for a longer time period, the footage will be tagged appropriately and retained beyond the 180-day time period.
 - Examples of footage that will be retained: footage depicting a UOF incident, footage depicting the seizure of evidence, footage that depicts damage to property or injury to person.



Other facts of note

- USMS is currently developing procedures for expedited release of BWC footage in cases of civil unrest. The appropriate USAO will be given advanced notification of these releases and an opportunity to consult on the release of DUSM BWC footage.
- BWC Policy for federal officers not finalized and subject to final approval from ODAG; changes in the policy could lead to delay in rollout of the program.
- Timeline for expansion of the BWC program to additional cities/locales is unclear.
- USMS also currently onboarding state and local partner agencies to the TFO BWC Program.

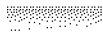

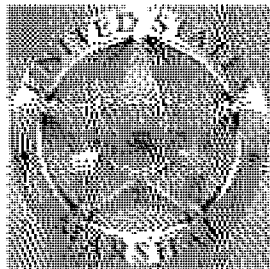

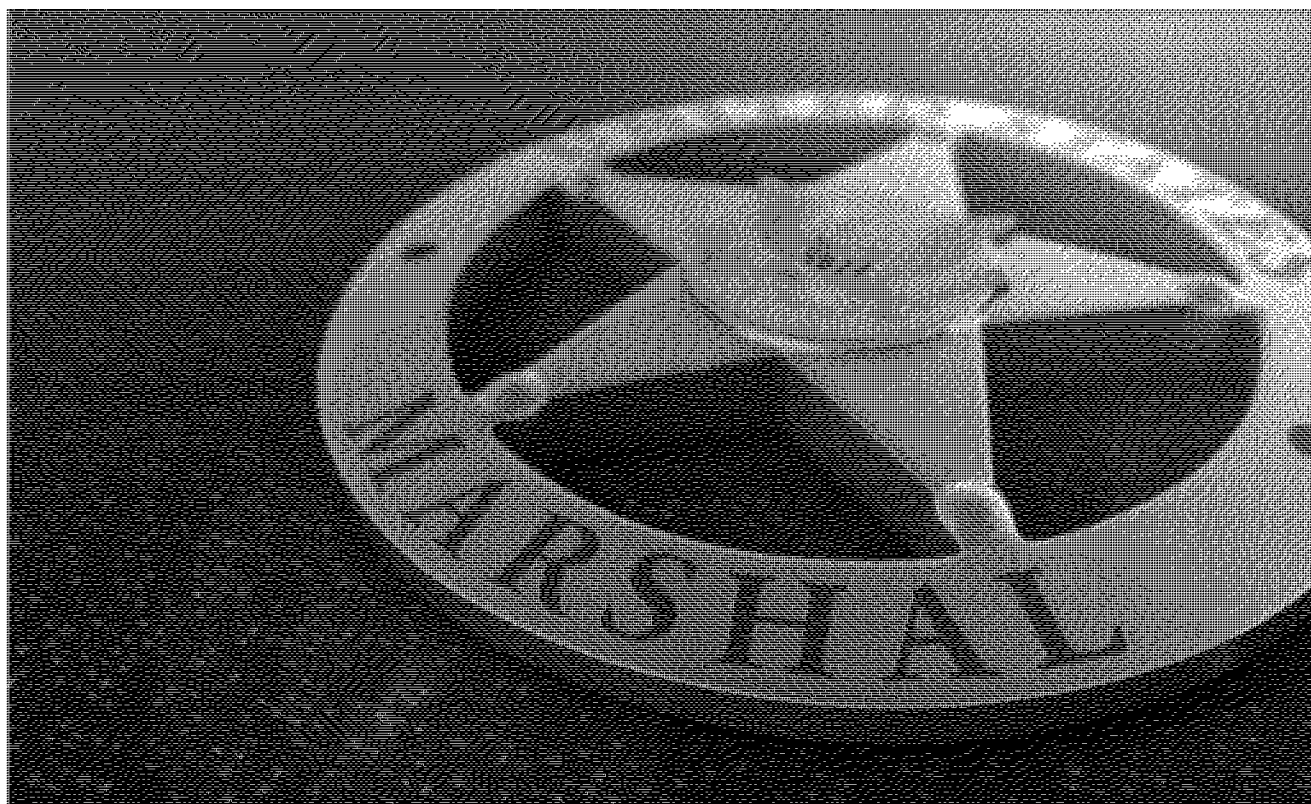
