As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) 5 U.S.C. § 552(c). Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) Intelligence Records. To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

Part 2: The standard responses below apply to all requests for records on individuals:

- (i) Requests for Records about any Individual—Watch Lists. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of any individual's name on a watch list pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(7)(E) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(7)(E), (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that watch list records do or do not exist.
- (ii) Requests for Records about any Individual—Witness Security Program Records. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records which could identify any participant in the Witness Security Program pursuant to FOIA exemption (b)(3) and PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(3), 18 U.S.C. 3521, and (j)(2)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.
- (iii) Requests for Confidential Informant Records. The FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of confidential informant records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(7)(D), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F) [5 U.S.C.§ § 552 (b)(7)(D), (b)(7)(E), and (b)(7)(F)] and Privacy Act exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C.§ 552a (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records would reveal confidential informant identities and information, expose law enforcement techniques, and endanger the life or physical safety of individuals. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

Part 3: General Information:

- (i) Record Searches and Standard Search Policy. The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems, such as the Central Records System (CRS), or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. The CRS is an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. The standard search policy is a search for main entity records in the CRS. Unless specifically requested, a standard search does not include a search for reference entity records, administrative records of previous FOIPA requests, or civil litigation files.
 - a. *Main Entity Records* created for individuals or non-individuals who are the subjects or the focus of an investigation
 - b. *Reference Entity Records* created for individuals or non-individuals who are associated with a case but are not known subjects or the focus of an investigation
- (ii) FBI Records. Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) Foreseeable Harm Standard. As amended in 2016, the Freedom of Information Act provides that a federal agency may withhold responsive records only if: (1) the agency reasonably foresees that disclosure would harm an interest protected by one of the nine exemptions that FOIA enumerates, or (2) disclosure is prohibited by law (5 United States Code, Section 552(a)(8)(A)(i)). The FBI considers this foreseeable harm standard in the processing of its requests.
- (iv) Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets. The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative "FBI file." An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS

SUBSECTIONS OF TITLE 5, UNITED STATES CODE, SECTION 552

- (b)(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified to such Executive order;
- (b)(2) related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency;
- (b)(3) specifically exempted from disclosure by statute (other than section 552b of this title), provided that such statute (A) requires that the matters be withheld from the public in such a manner as to leave no discretion on issue, or (B) establishes particular criteria for withholding or refers to particular types of matters to be withheld;
- (b)(4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential;
- (b)(5) inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency;
- (b)(6) personnel and medical files and similar files the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
- (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

- (d)(5) information compiled in reasonable anticipation of a civil action proceeding;
- (j)(2) material reporting investigative efforts pertaining to the enforcement of criminal law including efforts to prevent, control, or reduce crime or apprehend criminals;
- (k)(1) information which is currently and properly classified pursuant to an Executive order in the interest of the national defense or foreign policy, for example, information involving intelligence sources or methods;
- (k)(2) investigatory material compiled for law enforcement purposes, other than criminal, which did not result in loss of a right, benefit or privilege under Federal programs, or which would identify a source who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(3) material maintained in connection with providing protective services to the President of the United States or any other individual pursuant to the authority of Title 18, United States Code, Section 3056;
- (k)(4) required by statute to be maintained and used solely as statistical records;
- (k)(5) investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for Federal civilian employment or for access to classified information, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished information pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence;
- (k)(6) testing or examination material used to determine individual qualifications for appointment or promotion in Federal Government service the release of which would compromise the testing or examination process;
- (k)(7) material used to determine potential for promotion in the armed services, the disclosure of which would reveal the identity of the person who furnished the material pursuant to a promise that his/her identity would be held in confidence.

NATIONAL ISSUES

<u>Criminal Referral Letter: OPA</u> – U.S. Reps. Ted W. Lieu (D-California) and Kathleen Rice (D-New York) sent a criminal referral letter to the FBI requesting an investigation into alleged election crimes committed by President Trump during a phone call with Georgia Secretary of State Brad Raffensperger over the weekend. The president allegedly urged Raffensperger to "find" enough votes to overturn the state's results in the president's favor. OPA confirmed receipt of the letter sent to the FBI requesting an investigation, without further comment.

LOCAL STORIES

<u>Albuquerque</u> – The Santa Fe New Mexican asked if the FBI was still investigating the theft of six paintings that were stolen in Dallas around March 26, 2019, while they were being transported from Santa Fe to Louisiana. The reporter also wanted to know if the FBI had received any tips since Albuquerque distributed a news release and poster announcing a reward of up to \$8,000 in October. PAO advised the reporter the case remains under investigation, the FBI was looking into information it received from the public, and still is seeking more information.

<u>Albuquerque</u> – The Phoenix NBC affiliate interviewed PAO about the 13 Albuquerque and Phoenix posters that have been translated into the Navajo language in an effort to solve homicide and missing person cold cases on the nation's largest Native American reservation.

<u>Phoenix</u> – ASAC Moringiello spoke to a rotary club about the China Threat, including foreign government collection methods. PAS assisted the rotary club with a press release, which was sent to local news outlets and published in a local newspaper. The press release and newspaper article provided links to the FBI.Gov China Threat website and IC3.Gov.

<u>Pittsburgh</u> – Local media asked if the FBI was investigating several IEDs thrown from vehicles in local neighborhoods this morning. PAO confirmed we were assisting our LE partners, but referred media back to the city police department as it is the lead agency at this time.

<u>Pittsburgh</u> – WPXI interviewed SSA Lampo about an IC3 PSA that highlighted the increased use of mobile banking apps leading to exploitation. SSA Lampo talked about the need for people to be vigilant about the information they put online and having strong passwords with two-factor authentication. He also encouraged victims to report crimes to IC3.

Salt Lake City – The Utah Fox station interviewed SSA Scown about potential COVID vaccine scams.

<u>Salt Lake City</u> – A local NBC reporter asked if the FBI is investigating claims by the founder of Black Lives Matter Utah that her personal information was posted on social media. PAO did not confirm or deny an
investigation.

<u>Washington Field</u> – Several national media outlets asked about the FBI's posture for the reported protests this week in D.C. WFO provided the below statement: "The FBI's Washington Field Office respects the rights of individuals to peacefully exercise their First Amendment rights. We are committed to working closely with our local, state, and federal law enforcement partners to apprehend individuals who commit violence and criminal activity that constitutes a federal crime or poses a threat to national security. The FBI does not initiate investigations based solely on an individual's race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, or the exercise of First Amendment rights. We remind members of public to be aware of their surroundings and to report any suspicious activity to law enforcement."

<u>Washington Field</u> – Received several local and national inquiries about the alleged arrest of Enrique Tarrio, chairman of the Proud Boys. WFO referred media to D.C. Metropolitan Police.

NATIONAL ISSUES

<u>Air Threat: OPA</u> – A local TV station asked about a possible aviation threat against the U.S. Capitol. The inquiry was prompted by a CBS News report about a possible threat in retaliation for last year's death of Iranian Gen. Soulemani. OPA provided the following: "The FBI has no comment. However, the FBI takes all threats of violence to public safety seriously."

<u>Tindall: OPA/AT</u> – Vice News sought FBI comment about an FBI Atlanta subject indicted in September for lying about discussing potential attacks on both U.S. citizens and water and electrical infrastructure. Nicholas Tindall is awaiting trial, so OPA declined comment.

<u>PPE Disruption Sentencing, fbi.gov: OPA</u> – A disgruntled former employee of a medical equipment packaging company was sentenced for hacking into the company's computer systems and disrupting the shipment of personal protective equipment during the COVID-19 pandemic. The case is out of FBI Atlanta. Link to fbi.gov story: <u>https://www.fbi.gov/news/stories/hacker-who-disrupted-ppe-shipments-sentenced-010621</u>

U.S. CAPITOL VIOLENCE

Several field offices received inquiries related to the civil unrest and violence at the U.S. Capitol today.

<u>Baltimore</u> – Received inquiries from local press asking if Baltimore deployed personnel to help U.S. Capitol Police with the unrest. PAS provided the approved holding statement: "The FBI has been deployed to assist our U.S. Capitol Police partners as requested in protection of federal property and public safety."

<u>Boston</u> – Several reporters asked what FBI Boston is doing in light of today's events in Washington and if there are any related threats to our area. PAO advised that FBI Boston is monitoring the situation and at this point in time we don't have any intelligence about related threats to our area of responsibility, but we urge the public to remain vigilant and report to law enforcement if they see or hear anything suspicious.

<u>El Paso</u> – Media asked if FB El Paso is assisting the El Paso Police Department with local security during today's pro-Trump rallies. PAO provided the following NPO statement about civil unrest: "The FBI respects those who are exercising their First Amendment rights, including the right to peacefully protest. The FBI does not conduct surveillance based solely on First Amendment protected activity. The FBI continues to remain steadfast in our mission to protect the American people and uphold the U.S. Constitution. The FBI is supporting our state, local, and federal law enforcement partners with maintaining public safety by focusing our efforts on identifying, investigating, and disrupting individuals that are inciting violence and engaging in criminal activity."

<u>Indianapolis</u> – Received several media inquiries after reports the Indiana Statehouse was being evacuated due to the protests in D.C. at the Capitol. PAO declined to comment.

Los Angeles – In response to inquiries from local media about whether there are local threats based on the event at the Capitol, FBI Los Angeles issued the following statement, which is subject to change depending on any developments in the region: "While the FBI continually works with our partners to monitor potential threats, there is no known credible threat to the Los Angeles region at this time. As always, the FBI relies on the public to remain vigilant and to report any suspicious activity to the FBI or their local law enforcement agency."

<u>Philadelphia</u> – The CBS affiliate asked whether, in light of today's events in Washington, any additional security measures were implemented to protect the federal building and courthouse here. PAO advised that the Federal Protective Service is responsible for securing federal facilities and provided contact information for FPS public affairs.

<u>Seattle</u> – In consultation with OPA, responded to an inquiry from the ABC affiliate asking if the FBI is preparing for any response in the Seattle region to the electoral vote count and reports of rallies in the state capital. "The FBI remains steadfast in our mission to protect the American people and uphold the U.S. Constitution. We routinely work with our state, local, and federal partners to maintain public safety in the communities we serve, while respecting citizens' constitutional rights and civil liberties. As always, individuals are encouraged to peacefully exercise their First Amendment rights, but when those activities cross over into violence, the FBI is prepared to respond swiftly. For any inquiries related to events in Washington, D.C., or at the Capitol, please contact npo@fbi.gov."

<u>Washington Field</u> – In response to activity at the U.S. Capitol and reports of suspicious devices, Washington Field released the following two statements. **Suspicious Devices**: "Along with our law enforcement partners, FBI Washington Field Office responded to reports of suspicious devices. Two suspected explosive devices were rendered safe by the FBI and our law enforcement partners. The investigation is ongoing." **FBI Response to U.S. Capitol**: "The FBI has been deployed to assist our U.S. Capitol Police partners as requested in protection of federal property and public safety."

OTHER LOCAL STORIES

Anchorage – SAC Britt provided a quote for a press release from the USAO–District of Alaska announcing that the U.S. government collected \$7 million in Iranian assets for the victims of terrorism fund. Britt: "The FBI will aggressively pursue those who aid terrorist financiers and those who abuse the U.S. financial system in the process. Due to the collaborative effort put forth by the FBI and our partners, it is with great satisfaction that a portion of these successfully forfeited funds will go to American victims of international state-sponsored terrorism."

<u>Anchorage</u> – A local newspaper asked if FBI Anchorage received a letter from a state senator requesting an investigation into election-related crimes in Alaska. PAS responded: "The FBI acknowledges receipt of a letter from state Sen. Mike Shower concerning allegations of election crimes in Alaska. As a general matter, allegations of criminal conduct are reviewed by the FBI for their merit, with consideration of any applicable federal laws. Such a review does not necessarily result in the opening of an investigation but, when warranted, we take any actions appropriate to the matter, such as seeking further information or referring the matter to a partner agency."

<u>Boston</u> – SAC Bonavolonta provided a quote for a press release from the USAO–District of New Hampshire announcing today's guilty plea by Troy Cote to fentanyl trafficking. Bonavolonta: "This group's constant churn of drug transactions kept their customers in Manchester awash in deadly fentanyl and cocaine. Shutting them down makes the community safer, and with today's guilty plea—Troy Cote is out of business. Investigations like this illustrate the continuing impact our Safe Streets Gang Task Force has on illegal drug trafficking organizations that prey on our communities amid the opioid epidemic." <u>Cleveland</u> – SAC Smith participated in a joint ribbon-cutting ceremony officially opening the new Strike Force facility that will house over 207 law enforcement from several local, state and federal agencies. Smith spoke at the opening ceremony press conference and summarized the Strike Force's combined 20-month effort. Smith also provided a quote for the joint press release: "Cleveland is one of the largest Strike Forces in the nation. The need for such a capability comes as a response to a persistent and growing crime rate, but it also serves as a bulwark and a predictive unit to address the new threats we see ahead. This Strike Force represents the best of our combined efforts—law enforcement resources working violence, drugs, gangs, car jackings, and armed robberies—TOGETHER—under one roof. We know this unanimity of purpose and unity of effort, will only enhance our efforts to combat, disrupt and dismantle criminal activity."

<u>Houston</u> – PAO Garza did an on-camera interview in Spanish with Univision's nationally syndicated show Politica Ya about money mules.

Los Angeles – The San Gabriel Valley Tribune asked if the remains of a missing Los Angeles County man were found in Arizona. Los Angeles confirmed that agents are assisting police in California and Arizona in connection with the missing man, Shane Rollman, but referred inquiries about the recovered remains to authorities in Arizona.

<u>New Haven</u> – Received multiple local media inquiries about an FBI agent-involved shooting in Hartford earlier this morning. The subject was approached by members of the Safe Streets Task Force when the gunfire began. An agent on the Task Force and TFOs returned fire, striking and killing the subject at the scene. The investigation is ongoing and an initial brief statement was delivered by Connecticut State Police with no specific mention of FBI. SAC Sundberg will participate in presser at a later date.

<u>Philadelphia</u> – SAC Driscoll provided a quote for a press release from the USAO-Eastern District of Pennsylvania announcing that two North Carolina men have been charged in connection with the armed robbery of a Lancaster County dog breeder. Five French bulldog puppies valued at approximately \$24,000 were taken by force. Driscoll: "This wasn't just some dognapping caper, it was a violent armed robbery that saw the victim menaced at gunpoint. We're glad the FBI and our partners could help safely recover the pups, and determined to see the perpetrators held accountable."

<u>Philadelphia</u> – A Philadelphia Inquirer reporter writing about a cyber predator asked if FBI Philadelphia has seen a rise in reported attempts by such predators to target children online during the COVID-19 pandemic. PAO provided a quote from VCAC SSA confirming this, pointed the reporter to resources for parents and caregivers on FBI.gov, and suggested contacting NCMEC for additional context.

<u>Pittsburgh</u> – WPXI interviewed ASAC Olson about COVID vaccine fraud. He talked about the signs of potential scams, where to report fraud, and stressed not giving out personal information to anyone without verifying their legitimacy.

<u>Salt Lake City</u> – A local radio station asked if the FBI is aware of and/or investigating after social media video shows Sen. Mitt Romney being heckled at the Salt Lake International Airport and on a flight to D.C., where fellow passengers chanted "traitor." PAO advised we are aware of media reports but declined further comment.

<u>Tampa</u> – A local TV reporter interviewed SSA Givens about romance scams and how people may be more vulnerable to the scheme during the pandemic. Givens explained how to spot scams and why it's important for victims to report the crime. Givens also provided IC3 stats and information.

NATIONAL ISSUES

<u>Syria Torture: OPA</u> – CBS News 60 Minutes interviewed an individual who claims he was tortured in Syria in 2012. A producer asked if the FBI has any evidence to support his claims. The show does not plan to disclose the identity of the individual. OPA declined comment.

<u>China Espionage: OPA</u> – The De-Brief website asked how often individuals are targeted by China via professional networking and social media sites, whether such approaches are targeted at specific individuals, and what individuals should do if they think they are being targeted. OPA pointed to China materials on fbi.gov and usdoj.gov and provided some general language advising individuals to pay close attention to what they post online about themselves and any sensitive work they have done, and to contact the FBI if they feel they have been targeted by foreign intelligence services or by criminals.

<u>Upcoming Protest: OPA/WFO</u> – ABC News asked whether the FBI has information about planned violence at a January 6 Washington, DC protest, which will occur as Congress is scheduled to certify the results of the presidential election. ABC also asked if the FBI is issuing any bulletins on this topic. OPA and WFO declined comment.

<u>Samuel Little Death: OPA</u> – Received inquiries from national and local outlets asking about the death of Samuel Little, the <u>most prolific serial killer in U.S. history</u>, who died yesterday while serving three consecutive life terms without parole. Little was convicted in 2014 on three counts of murder; he had confessed to 93. The FBI's Violent Criminal Apprehension Program analysts helped link numerous cases to Little and law enforcement have been able to verify at least 50 confessions. OPA declined to comment on Little's death and referred inquiries about specific victims to the lead local law enforcement agencies.

<u>COVID-19 Vaccine Destruction: OPA/MK</u> – Received multiple inquiries regarding a Wisconsin hospital worker who admitted to destruction of more than 500 Moderna vaccines. OPA declined to comment on the existence of an investigation, per policy.

LOCAL STORIES

<u>Boston</u> – A reporter with the local NPR station requested an interview to discuss today's ruling by the Mass. Supreme Judicial Court involving the production of FBI records relating to the 2015 shooting of Usaamah Rahim by an FBI agent and Boston police officer. The reporter incorrectly read the decision and believed the Court advised the Suffolk County District Attorney to turn over some FBI records to Rahim's mother, stating that the records should be considered public according to the Mass. public records law. PAO declined comment citing ongoing litigation and urged the reporter to re-read the decision and seek clarification from the Suffolk County DA's office because her understanding of the ruling was not accurate.

Las Vegas – SAC Rouse provided a quote for a press release from the USAO announcing five federal charges

filed from a human trafficking takedown earlier this month. SAC Rouse: "The FBI will always be vigilant in pursuing those who choose to prey on our most vulnerable, especially our children. I would like to thank our law enforcement partners and their task force officers as part of the FBI's Child Exploitation Task Force for their commitment to making these arrests."

<u>Las Vegas</u> – Significant media inquiries and coverage following the arrest of five individuals; a result of a lengthy multi-jurisdictional investigation by the Henderson, Nev. Police Department, the Houston Police Department, FBI Houston, FBI New Orleans, and FBI Las Vegas. Investigation revealed the suspects would steal a large truck and pull the ATMs from the ground in a series of robberies similar in nature. PAOs directed inquiries to the press release issued by Henderson PD and declined further comment.
