

# HOUSE APPROVES PRESIDENT LIMIT

State Delegates Vote 84-27;  
Issue Goes To Senate

Two-term limit on presidents becomes law with Nevada being thirty-sixth State to act. .Page 1

Annapolis, Feb. 26—Too late to make any practical difference, the House of Delegates tonight voted for ratification of an amendment to the Federal Constitution limiting a President's terms to two.

While the House was debating the question, word was received that Nevada had become the thirty-sixth State to ratify the amendment, which thus becomes law.

The House vote on a resolution to ratify was 84 to 27. The matter now goes before the Senate.

Most, though not all, of the delegates appeared to lose interest in the amendment after they learned that Maryland had no chance of achieving such fame as would have come from its having been the ratifying State.

## Governor Favors Ratification

Horace P. Whitworth, Jr., Allegany county Republican and sponsor of the resolution, had hoped to obtain that honor for Maryland.

Mr. Whitworth, confident that the House would vote for ratification, had waited for some time in
