

acting as President, during the term within which this Article becomes operative from holding the office of President or acting as President during the remainder of such term.

"Sec. 2. This article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the Constitution by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States within seven years from the date of its submission to the States by the Congress."

Therefore, be it Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the legislature of the state of New York does hereby ratify the above recited proposed amendment to the constitution of the United States.

And be it further Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the secretary of state be requested to transmit a certified copy of this concurrent resolution to the secretary of state of the United States of America."

having been announced for a third reading,

Debate was had thereon.

Said resolution was then read the third time, having been printed and upon the desks of the members in its final form at least three calendar legislative days prior to its final passage.

Mr. Speaker put the question whether the House would agree to the final passage of said resolution and it was determined in the affirmative, a majority of all the members elected to the Assembly voting in favor thereof and three-fifths being present.
