

# SCHEDULE F DATA CALL

On October 21, the President signed Executive Order (EO) 13957, <u>Creating Schedule F in the Excepted Service</u>. Positions in the new Schedule F authority are considered to be of a confidential, policy-determining, policy-making, or policy-advocating character not normally subject to a change as a result of a Presidential transition.

As a result of the EO, the Office of the Chief Human Capital Officer (HC) will be developing a comprehensive Schedule F Excepted Service policy for implementation at the Department. However, the first requirement in the EO mandates that agencies submit an initial list of possible positions to the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for approval within 90 days (January 19, 2021). Upon OPM approval, positions submitted for consideration may be converted from the competitive service or other excepted service (e.g., Schedule A) to Schedule F.

This initial submission is a preliminary draft for OPM to review. The Department will have the ability to amend its position list when it submits its final approval list to OPM in 210 days (May 19, 2021). OPM retains final authority over which categories and types of positions will be placed in Schedule F.

## Position Characteristics for Inclusion in Schedule F

Determinations that positions should be moved into the new Schedule F authority must be based on the position duties (i.e., position description (PD)) vice the duties the current incumbent is performing. If necessary, the PD may need to be updated to more accurately reflect the duties of the position if it is outdated. As outlined in EO 13957, below are characteristics indicating a position may belong in Schedule F:

- 1) Substantive participation in the advocacy for or the development or formulation of policy, especially:
  - Substantive participation in the development or drafting of regulations and guidance; or
  - Substantive policy-related work in an agency or agency component that primarily focuses on policy.
- 2) Supervision of attorneys.
- 3) Substantial discretion to determine the manner in which the agency exercises functions committed to the agency by law.
- 4) Viewing, circulating, or otherwise working with proposed regulations, guidance, executive orders, or other non-public policy proposals or deliberations generally covered by deliberative process privilege and either:
  - Directly reporting to or regularly working with an individual appointed by either the President or an agency head who is paid at a rate not less than that earned by employees at Grade 13 of the General Schedule; or
  - Working in the agency or agency component executive secretariat (or equivalent).
- 5) Conducting, on the agency's behalf, collective bargaining negotiations under chapter 71 of title 5, United States Code.
