"Any person judicially convicted of the violation of this Section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine in the sum of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not to exceed 30 days or by both said fine and imprisonment."

And as so amended Do Pass.
