SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT: I move to amend the Standing Rules and Orders for the government of the Senate as follows: *

Senate Rule No. 1 to read as follows: "1. The President shall take the chair every legislative day at precisely 10:00 o'clock A.M. and 2:00 o'clock P.M., unless the Senate by motion adopted by a majority vote shall have agreed to convene at some other hour."

Rule 4, second paragraph, line 7, by deleting the "period" following the word "announced" and adding the following words: "As recorded, and the official roll call sheet shall never in any way be altered or the votes recorded thereon changed."

Rule 7, section 1, line 2, by deleting the numeral "5" and inserting in lieu thereof the numeral "7".

Rule 9, to read as follows: "9. Following the first order of business any Senator may call up for consideration any contest which may have been reported by the Committee on Elections, or a majority thereof, and shall be entitled to address the Senate thereon."

Rule 10, lines 2 and 3, by deleting the words "during the sitting of the Senate" and substituting the words "while the Senate is convened,"

Rule 13, line 2, by deleting the word "bar" and substituting the word "chamber".

Rule 14, lines 3 and 4, by deleting the words "or to suspend the further reading of the minutes".

Rule 20 to read as follows: "20. No motion to amend or any committee action upon a bill or resolution shall be in order which seeks under color of amendment to substitute or insert subject matter not germane to that under consideration."

Rule 21 to read as follows: "21. When action has been taken on any matter before the Senate, (except a motion to adjourn, recess, table, take from table, or suspend rules or order of business), it shall be in order for any Senator of the prevailing side to move a reconsideration thereof, but such motion to reconsider shall not be in order unless made within three calendar days, except Sunday, following the action. But no matter shall be reconsidered more than once during the session."

Rule 25, to read as follows: "25. No bill shall be introduced unless it first be checked by the Legislative Reference Bureau as to technical
