

Senate to Consider 2-Term Amendment

OKLAHOMA CITY, April 10 (U.P.)—A joint resolution ratifying a United States constitutional amendment to limit presidential terms of office was introduced in the Oklahoma senate today by Sen. Perry Howell, Blackwell republican, and a group of fellow senators.

The amendment, if ratified by 36 states, would limit presidential tenure to two full terms or a total of not more than 10 years in event the vice-president succeeded to the office at mid-term.
