

Mark Holiday Voted 'For'

Representative Mark Holiday joined forces with republicans Friday in an unsuccessful effort to bring the bill which would ratify the twenty-second amendment to the U. S. constitution from committee into the house for a vote, according to an Associated Press dispatch from Olympia.

The measure, which would limit a president of the United States to two terms in office, passed the senate 27 to 18 last Monday, but has since been tied up in the house elections committee.

Holiday joined three other house democrats in opposition to a proposal which would leave the measure in the committee. The proposal, which passed 48 to 46, blocked action by republican Representative Berry Woodall which would have forced the committee to release the measure for a vote of the full house membership.
