**PLAINTIFF’S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT’S
NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY**

On October 12, 2017, defendant U.S. Department of Justice (“DOJ”) filed a notice of supplemental authority calling the Court’s attention to a recent opinion and order in *Campaign for Accountability v. Dep’t of Justice*, Civil No. 16-1068 (KBJ) (D.D.C.) (Dkt. 19). Although the court in that case dismissed the complaint, plaintiff was afforded until October 27, 2017, to amend its complaint.

As of this date, Campaign for Accountability has not indicated how it will proceed. Accordingly, plaintiff hereby advises the Court that once that decision is made, plaintiff will so advise the Court and will move to file a supplemental memorandum addressing the opinion in the *Campaign for Accountability* case and plaintiff’s position on how to proceed in this case, with DOJ having a right to reply to our supplemental memorandum.
