## PLAINTIFF'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY

On October 12, 2017, defendant U.S. Department of Justice ("DOJ") filed a notice of supplemental authority calling the Court's attention to a recent opinion and order in *Campaign* for Accountability v. Dep't of Justice, Civil No. 16-1068 (KBJ) (D.D.C.) (Dkt. 19). Although the court in that case dismissed the complaint, plaintiff was afforded until October 27, 2017, to amend its complaint.
