**PLAINTIFF’S SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT’S
NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY**

On October 12, 2017, defendant U.S. Department of Justice (“DOJ”) filed a notice of supplemental authority (Dkt. 19) calling the Court’s attention to a recent opinion and order in *Campaign for Accountability v. Dep’t of Justice*, Civil No. 16-1068 (KGB) (D.D.C.), dismissing the complaint with leave to amend by October 27, 2017. In response, plaintiff Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington advised the Court it would provide an update once the plaintiff in *Campaign for Accountability* had decided whether to file an amended complaint (Dkt. 20).

Pursuant to that representation, plaintiff hereby notes that on October 27, 2017, Campaign for Accountability filed an amended complaint (Dkt. 22). Plaintiff notes further that the amended complaint in the *Campaign for Accountability* lawsuit may bring that case and this one within the scope of LCvR 40.5(b)(3) as related cases.
