## Dear Ms. Weismann:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated September 10, 2018, which was sent to the FOIA Service of the Department of Veterans Affairs, received by that office on September 11, 2018 and referred to my office on September 19, 2018. Your request is for the following:

- 1. Copies of records sufficient to show all travel taken or planned by all presidentially-appointed Senate confirmed ("PAS") officials in the VA to any event attended by a sitting member of the United States House of Representatives in that member's district between May 1, 2018 through November 6, 2018.
- 2. Copies of records sufficient to show all the political events to which PAS officials in the VA traveled from January 20, 2017 to the present, identifying the event, agency participants, and the costs of each trip.
- 3. Copies of records sufficient to show all the political events PAS officials in the VA are scheduled to attend in 2018, including but not limited to those events expected to have mixed travel, i.e., travel for official and political purposes, identifying the event, agency participants, and anticipated costs of each scheduled trip.
- 4. Copies of records sufficient to show the formula the VA uses to apportion costs incurred during travel that has both official and political components.
- 5. Copies of all records concerning how the VA ensures compliance with the Hatch Act's restrictions on political travel.

You asked that we search for responsive records regardless of format, medium, or physical characteristics. You are seeking records of any kind, including paper records, electronic records, audiotapes, videotapes, photographs, data, and graphical material. You wish to have included without limitation all correspondence, letters, emails, text messages, facsimiles, telephone messages, voice mail messages, and transcripts, notes, or minutes of any meetings, telephone conversations or discussions. Your request includes any attachments to emails and other records, as well as those who were cc'ed or bcc'ed on any emails.

The Board of Veterans' Appeals has one PAS employee, Cheryl L. Mason, the Chairman of the Board. Ms. Mason was sworn in on December 11, 2017. From January 20, 2017 to December 11, 2017, the position of the Chairman was vacant.

My search produced a four-page travel voucher describing the Chairman's trip to attend the Congressional Veterans and Service Officer Seminar, hosted by Congressman Larry Bucshon, MD, from August 7 to August 8, 2018. Attached please find the Agenda for the meeting and a copy of that voucher, redacted pursuant to exemption b6 of the FOIA to prevent a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, and exemption b5.

5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(5) exempts from disclosure "inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters which would not be available by law to a party other than an agency in litigation with the agency." The government is entitled to redact confidential government information given "the sensitivity of the commercial secrets involved, and the harm that would be inflicted upon the Government by premature disclosure." Federal Open Market Committee v. Merrill, 443 U.S. 340, 363 (1979). Here the redacted information is accounting codes and labels. The release of this information might expose the government to hacking liabilities, banking or wire fraud, and financial security risks.

This voucher and the enclosed agenda of the meeting the Chairman attended are the only documents in the Board's possession found to be responsive to your requests numbered 1, 2 and 3. The Board has no records responsive to your fourth and fifth requests.

With the redactions and lack of responsive records, I consider this to be a partial grant of your request. If you are unsatisfied with this response, please know that as part of the 2007 FOIA amendments, the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) was created to offer mediation services. Similarly, as part of the FOIA Improvement Act of 2016, VA established a FOIA Public Liaison to offer mediation services. Both OGIS and the VA Public Liaison will assist in resolving disputes between FOIA requesters and VA as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation. Using OGIS or the VA FOIA Public Liaison does not affect your right to pursue litigation. You may contact OGIS or the VA Public Liaison in any of the following ways:
