2. **CVE Grants Notice of Funding:** Attachment two, sorry to be redundant (Katie and John have seen this), but for a good of the group please see detailed outline of the CVE Grant program. This Notice was approved by Republican majority Appropriations and Authorizing Committees in the past 6-months.

Next batch of emails will include letters of congressional interest and tomorrow we will share consolidated outcomes and evaluation methods for each of the intended grant awardees.

In terms of a work plan for this week and next here is my proposal:

1. **Jan 27:** Lets plan to do a 60-90min meeting at the NAC to review what we have covered to date, materials delivered and outstanding, and an overall plan to get you everything you need to conduct an exhaustive review of the grant program.
2. **Jan 30:** Stating next week I'd like to hold a few sessions on the following issues (1) deep-dive of each NGO awardee application and discussion of scouring process, (2) overview of proposed performance metrics and additional evaluation tools available at DHS S&T, (3) briefing from I&A on the security review conducted, and (4) briefing on the Joint Explanatory Statement from Congress and a discussion with our CFO team on use of funds for this grant program. When we meet on Friday we can set the schedule for next week with one or more sessions per day.
3. **Feb 6:** We reconvene to asses where we are and a path forward to brief DCOS.
4. **Feb 8:** We meet with DCOS to brief on what we did and our recommendations or points of disagreement.

Hi John, thanks for the questions.

1. **Event:** regarding the link below, we have no knowledge of the event at all. By the looks like it this was a CRCL project. CRCL has had an engagement roundtable in central Florida for several years and I am aware that CAIR participates as a self-proclaimed civil rights group. I wasn't aware of this training and not aware that anyone on my staff was involved at all.
2. **Contracts/Grants:** I'm aware that at some point in the past 2-3 years CAIR (not sure which chapter) did receive some type of FEMA grant. Not sure which grant program exactly, you would need to ask FEMA. No other previously or currently contracted or granted dollars by OCP or other DHS entities I know of off-hand to un-indicted co-conspirators.
3. **HLF Trial:** Regarding your critique of my answer at my hearing last year, I wanted to clarify that there is currently no law, policy, or regulation in effect that would prohibit any part of the USG from having any kind of relationship with an un-indicted co-conspirator. My answer at the hearing was factual and both vetted and approved by DHS OGC. I fully understand this is a contentious issue and I'd welcome further discussion. If/when MB is designated as an FTO that would give DHS and other agencies the legal backing to take appropriate actions domestically, but until then, the court case has been narrowly interpreted by DOJ and DHS dating back to the Bush Administration as Frank referenced.

Really appreciate the extra time you, Frank, and Katie spent with us yesterday. We are currently preparing a package of materials that cover the issues we discussed, please give me another day or so to pull everything together. In terms of work tempo with you all I'd like to suggest we identify a few 60-90min blocks two or three times a week to do deep-dives on anything you want to discuss. Can we start Friday? This might be more than necessary, but I want to air on the side of being overly inclusive with everything from day one given your interest and the importance of the issue. DCOS Metzler told David this morning that he would like (b)(6) to be involved in some of our discussions so she is copied here.

Last, there was some mention of an outside group of experts to give the Secretary advice on CVE. I'm completely supportive of outside input, including from critics, but I should note that in the past 6-months at least four different outside groups have provided recommendations on domestic CVE efforts. That includes a CSIS group chaired by (b)(6) and Leon Panetta, a Washington Institute group chaired by (b)(6) The Aspen Security Group chaired by Secretary Chertoff and (b)(6) and our Homeland Security Advisory Council in June 2016: [LINK](#). I'm ready to consider any options or proposals, but wanted you to be aware that we have been extensively "reviewed" in the past 6-months, but please send proposed names and a concept paper when you can. Ready and willing to consider a new approach.

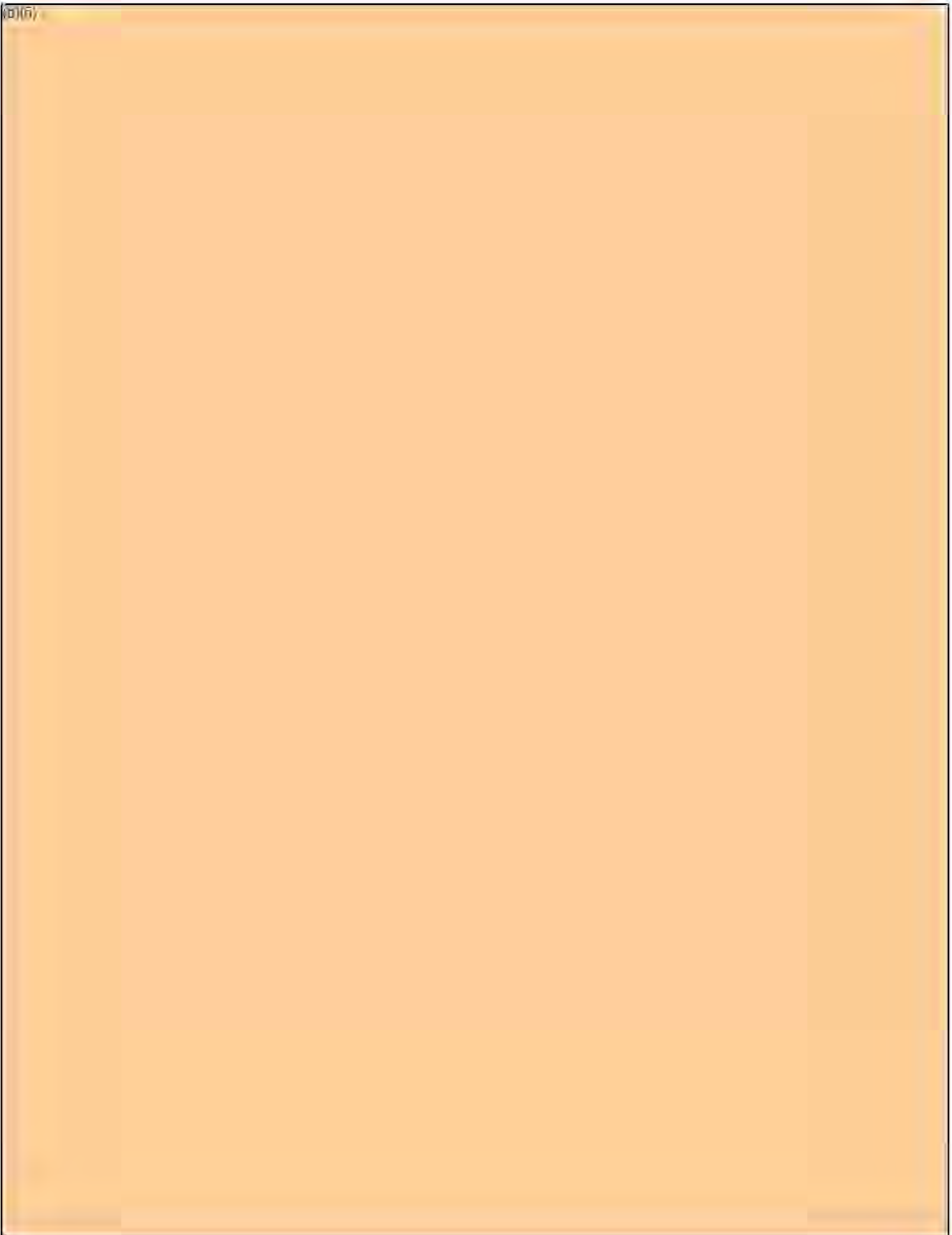

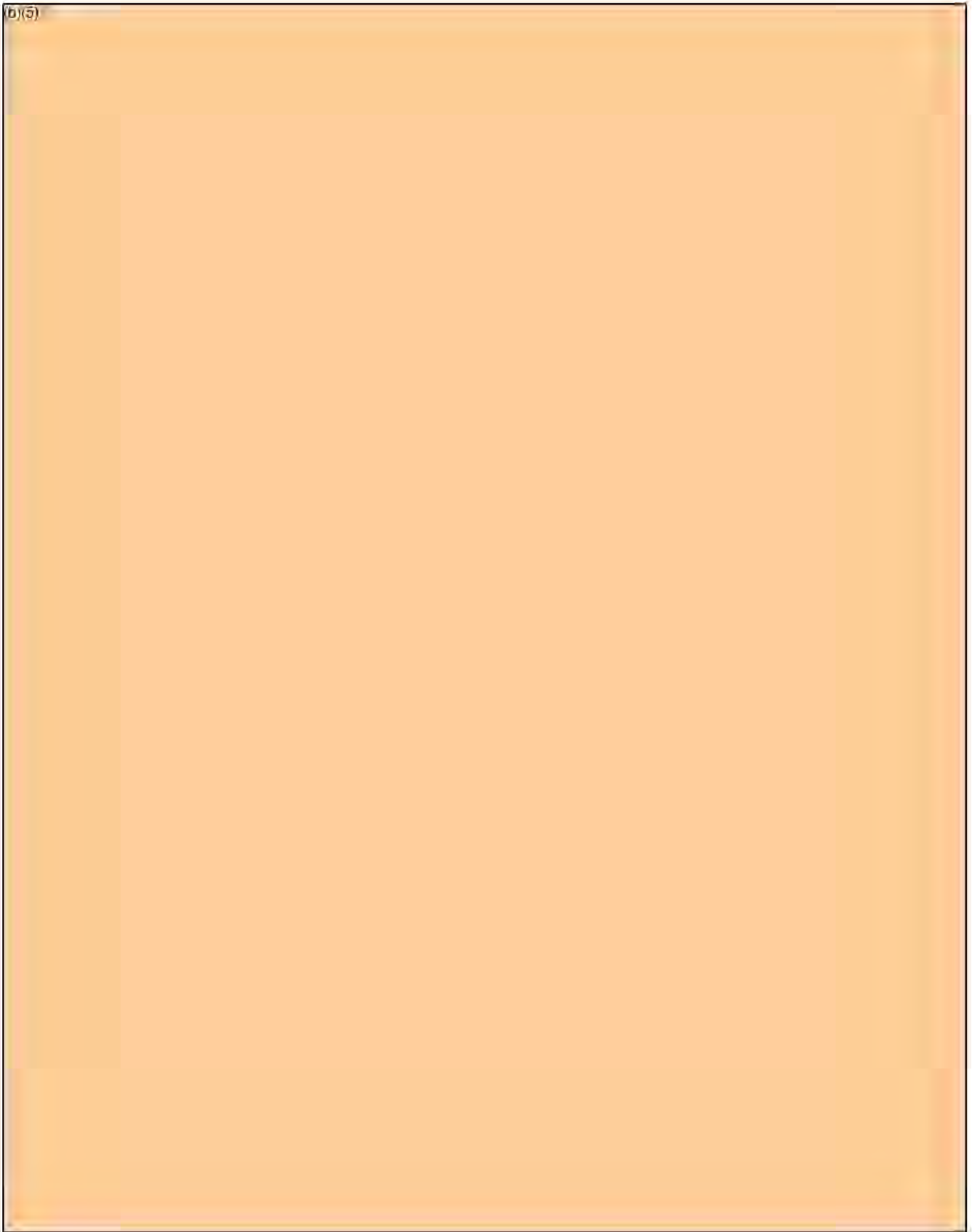

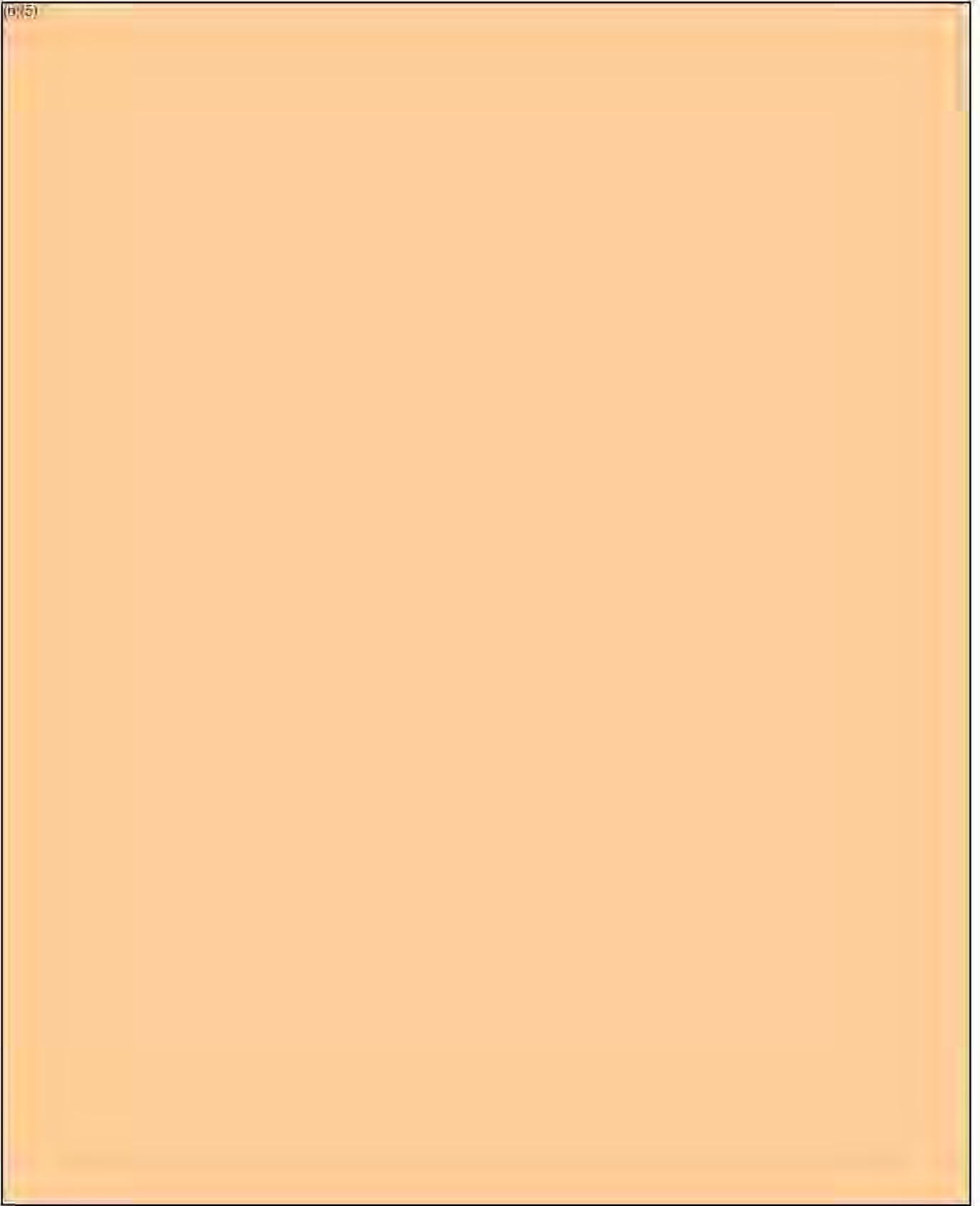

Hi John, thanks for the questions.

1. **Event:** regarding the link below, we have no knowledge of the event at all. By the looks like it this was a CRCL project. CRCL has had an engagement roundtable in central Florida for several years and I am aware that CAIR participates as a self-proclaimed civil rights group. I wasn't aware of this training and not aware that anyone on my staff was involved at all.
2. **Contracts/Grants:** I'm aware that at some point in the past 2-3 years CAIR (not sure which chapter) did receive some type of FEMA grant. Not sure which grant program exactly, you would need to ask FEMA. No other previously or currently contracted or granted dollars by OCP or other DHS entities I know of off-hand to un-indicted co-conspirators.
3. **HLF Trial:** Regarding your critique of my answer at my hearing last year, I wanted to clarify that there is currently no law, policy, or regulation in effect that would prohibit any part of the USG from having any kind of relationship with an un indicted co-conspirator. My answer at the hearing was factual and both vetted and approved by DHS OGC. I fully understand this is a contentious issue and I'd welcome further discussion. If/when MB is designated as an FTO that would give DHS and other agencies the legal backing to take appropriate actions domestically, but until then, the court case has been narrowly interpreted by DOJ and DHS dating back to the Bush Administration as Frank referenced.

Really appreciate the extra time you, Frank, and Katie spent with us yesterday. We are currently preparing a package of materials that cover the issues we discussed, please give me another day or so to pull everything together. 
like (b)(6) to be involved in some of our discussions so she is copied here.

Last, there was some mention of an outside group of experts to give the Secretary advice on CVE. I'm completely supportive of outside input, including from critics, but I should note that in the past 6-months at least four different outside groups have provided recommendations on domestic CVE efforts. That includes a CSIS group chaired by Tony Blair and Leon Panetta, a Washington Institute group chaired by (b)(6) The Aspen Security Group chaired by Secretary Chertoff and Jane Harman, and our Homeland Security Advisory Council in June 2016: [LINK](#). I'm ready to consider any options or proposals, but wanted you to be aware that we have been extensively "reviewed" in the past 6-months, but please send proposed names and a concept paper when you can. Ready and willing to consider a new approach.
